In this week's Gospel, we hear Luke's account of the three temptations Jesus faces in the desert. The temptation story takes place after Jesus's baptism in the Jordan and before his public ministry.

For forty days, Jesus undergoes repeated testing by the devil and is exposed to the human experience of temptation. Jesus is tempted with good things; and he is faced with actions that would lead him away from God. To give him strength, he responds to each temptation with a passage from Scripture.

"One does not live on bread alone."

"You shall worship the Lord, your God,

"You shall not put the Lord, your God, to the test."

Jesus was able to meet each temptation with confidence. He did not doubt his relationship with God.

During Lent, we are given an opportunity to sort our priorities—a time to pray and reflect on how we live, serve God, and are being mindful of those in need. Prayer, fasting, and almsgiving helps us to put our trust in God, especially in times of doubt, decision making, and tough times.

On Tuesday, in preparation for Lent, the school students participated in a palm burning ceremony that was led by Dcn Jerry Szostak.

Our 4th, 5th, 7th and 8th grade homerooms will each lead one of the weekly Lenten Prayer Services. Under the direction of Miss Nagle, the sixth grade will lead the school's Living Stations on April 14 at 12:30 p.m. (*Students from OLBS Youth Ministry will also lead Living Stations for the parish at St. Julian Eymard at 7pm on Good Friday*)

Lenten resolutions are not only giving up or doing away with something, but they can also be positive actions—building ups. During the month of March, we are working on empathy—the ability to share or understand the emotions and feelings of another person. The goal is to promote a culture of building up versus tearing down.

We have launched a social-emotional character development program called Friendly. SEL (Social Emotional Learning) is the process through which people learn to recognize and manage emotions, care about others, make good decisions, behave ethically and responsibly, develop positive relationships, and avoid negative behaviors.

The Friendly Curriculum teaches five core competencies of Social and Emotional Learning: self-awareness, self-management, responsible decision making, social awareness and relationship skills. Each unit has a catchphrase that is a familiar, understandable way to communicate with others and remind everyone how to connect and become a community.




