

## THOUGHTS ON THE SUPREME COURT'S DECISION IN *DOBBS V. JACKSON WOMEN'S HEALTH ORGANIZATION*

When I first got the flash on my cell phone of the Supreme Court decision that overturned Roe v. Wade my first thought was of my late mother.

Mary Bliss was one of the few people who objected to the 1973 court ruling that made abortion a legal avenue for women to take the life of their unborn child. She was one of a handful of people at that time who stood up for the life of the unborn, becoming a board member of Illinois Citizens for Life and leading a small but powerful organization in educating the public about the horror of abortion.

Later she sifted her attention towards those women who "chose" to have their baby and created Project Love, a social service outreach of ICL that gave financial aid to pregnant women and mothers of newborns. Today Project Love continues through Illinois Right to Life and helps those mothers, or mothers to be, with assistance to pay rent, utility bills, car repairs and other needs.

When listening to Sunday's readings, Paul's letter to the Galatians particularly struck me:

"Brothers and sisters: For freedom Christ set us free; so stand firm and do not submit again to the yoke of slavery.

For you were called to freedom, brothers and sisters. But do not use this freedom as an opportunity for the flesh; rather serve one another through love. For the whole law is fulfilled in one statement: You shall love your neighbor as yourself.

But if you go on biting and devouring one another, beware that you are not consumed by one another."

How apropos are those words today. We live in a society where a life is considered nonexistent if it does not reside outside the womb. If, by chance, a woman gets pregnant and doesn't want the child, she can have it removed and thrown in the garbage like a left-over slice of pizza. Is this what God intended when he created man and woman, to become one in Him and beget children in His Image and Likeness?

So, while last Friday was a glorious day for those who have fought the long battle in overturning an erroneous decision from the start, the war continues. Here in Illinois, abortion will continue as long as those who don't value life remain in control of government. We, as a faith community, need to show our brothers and sisters who feel abortion is a "right" that life is "sacred" from the start—that only God can end it—not man.

But we need to do so in the words of St. Paul—"you shall love your neighbor as yourself." We need to show love and compassion for those on the other side—no matter how hard that can be, and it is hard. We cannot go on "biting and devouring one another"—otherwise, we will consume ourselves.

That is why the Respect Life Ministry here at OLBS will continue to pray for a culture of life and support those who choose life. We will continue our effort to educate about the evil of abortion and its aftereffects. And we will continue to give support—monetarily and spiritually—through our Season for Life campaign that benefits crisis pregnancy centers and programs like Project Love.


