Dear Friends,

As we celebrate the Feast of the Ascension of our Lord, we are reminded of the great commission that Jesus gave to his disciples to go forth and make disciples of all nations. In today's Gospel of Matthew, we read of Jesus' final words to his disciples before he ascends into heaven: ***Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the holy Spirit*** (Matthew 28:19).

This mission of spreading the Gospel is one that we are all called to as members of Christ's Church. We are called to emulate Jesus, to care for those in need and to welcome the stranger. As a parish, we have the opportunity to live out this mission through our **Welcome the Stranger Parish-Family Sponsorship Program**.

As you may know, our parish has been paired with a young family: dad, Italo, mom, Jugla, 3-year-old daughter, Chloe, and a baby on the way. This family has fled their home in Peru due to violence and persecution and is now seeking safety and a new life here in our community. We have been given the opportunity to help them in their journey by providing support and assistance through our sponsorship program.

I am pleased to announce that through our Lenten Almsgiving, we have raised \$10,000 towards the support of this family. Thank you for your generosity, this is a wonderful start! But, as you know, the cost of living can be quite high, especially for a family with young children. While this amount will certainly help, it is not likely to cover their expenses for six months as initially hoped.

One essential way to support this family is by finding them a safe and affordable place to live, a home. More than just shelter from the elements, a home represents safety and security. A home is where families gather and memories are made. Our liaison team, working with Catholic Charities resettlement specialists, has already begun this important work. But nobody knows our community quite like we do,

and so I am asking that if you or someone you know has or knows of an affordable place to rent (we're hoping to find something for \$1200 or less per month), that you please contact our parish office. Your support in this way will be a great blessing to this family.

Another practical way we can help this family is by continuing to support them financially. In addition to rent, they will also need to pay for utilities, food, clothing and other essentials. If you are able to continue contributing towards their support, please consider doing so and continue to mark donations "Welcome the Stranger." You may drop donation envelopes in the parish offertory or deliver to our parish office (601 Biesterfield Road, Elk Grove Village, IL 6007). Any amount, no matter how small, will make a difference in the lives of this family and show them healing, hope and hospitality.

Let us continue to keep Italo, Jugla, Chloe and the baby on the way in our prayers and to work together to help them in any way we can. May the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with us all.

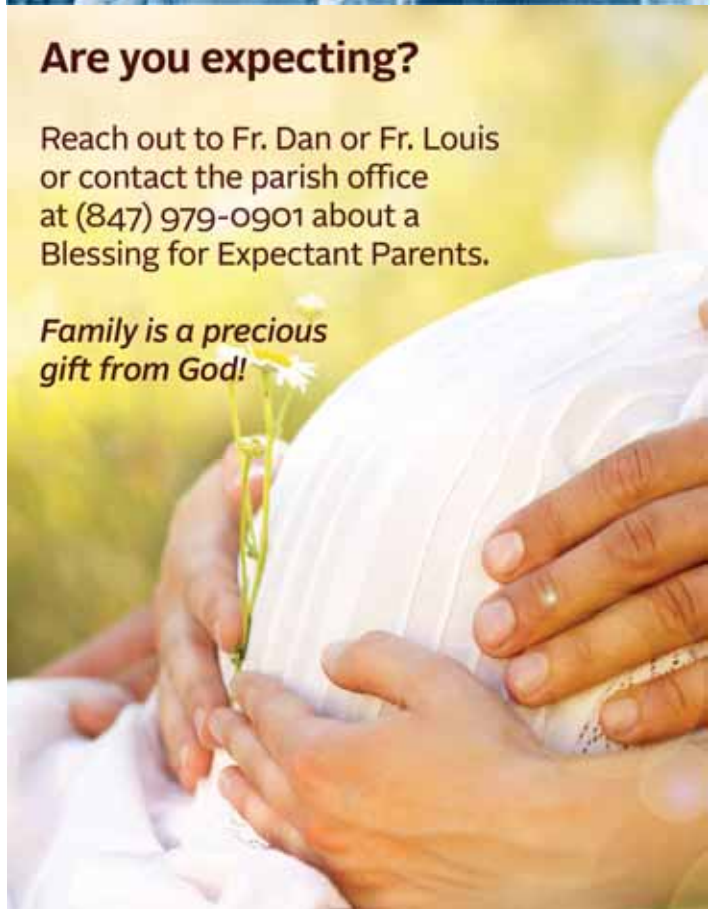

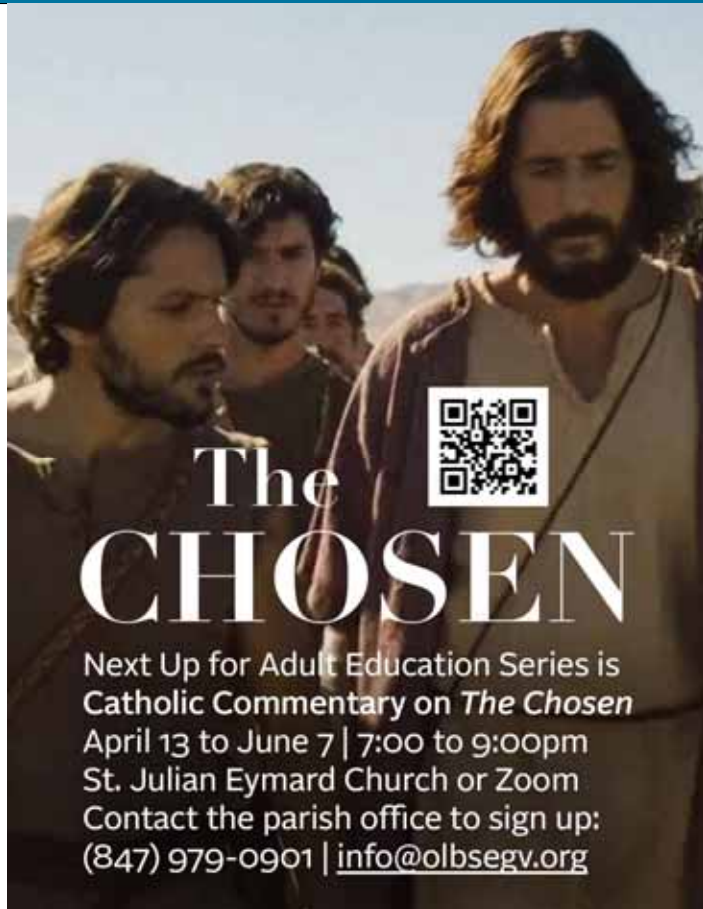
