A REFLECTION FROM MARRIAGE & FAMILY MINISTRY

The Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ

Hello my brothers and sisters in Christ. This weekend we celebrate Corpus Christi, The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. This description, in words, still leaves me in awe. That God decides in His divine and perfect plan to deliver Himself in His son—Jesus. And Jesus knows what He has to do, not only because He is one with God, but also because of His love and "submission" to our Father's will. He gives himself up not only to the cross, but to us daily, ever since the last supper in the form of bread and wine.

At Mass, at the moment of Consecration, the priest, just as Christ did, pronounces a blessing over the bread and wine, and repeats the Lord's words, "Take and eat it," "This is my Body," "This is my blood which seals God's covenant, my blood poured out for the forgiveness of sins." The miracle of "Transubstantiation" takes place. This is the mystery of our faith. For each and everyone one of us, the mystery lessens when we truly spend time with the Lord. Time spent in prayer with Him, in Adoration.

I will liken the time in Adoration to the time I spent in church with my grandfather. I was 6 years old and visiting Ecuador. Grandpa asked if I wanted to go to San Francisco. I politely said, "Grandpa, San Francisco is in California." He laughed and said "the church." I said ok, even though I didn't want to go to church. The next couple of hours served as an example to me for the rest of my life. Submission is the key. Submission like that of a child obeying their parents when given a task or words of advice. So why is it that as adults we find it difficult to submit? I'm in a very happy and healthy marriage. For this to be possible I must submit, with all my senses, to my spouse whom I trust. And, vice versa. She and I understand that our marriage isn't just between us, but it also includes the Holy Trinity. I for one will not say no to the Holy Trinity. Like the person who is drowning and struggling until the lifeguard tells them, "Stop fighting and remain still, so I can save you. It'll be easier for us."

If you are someone that truly sees Jesus in the Eucharist, thank Him for this blessing. For my brothers and sisters that do not see Him and struggle, but still submit to His will and words, Jesus has spoken and said this to you; (Jn 20:29) "Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed."

To all of you, Jesus invites you to come and sit with Him in Adoration. Our current schedule for Adoration at Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament is:

- Wednesday after the 8:15am Mass until 8pm (or when reconciliation ends) with Closing Benediction (St. Julian Eymard Church)
- Every 1st Friday after the 8:15am Mass until closing Benediction at 11:30am (St. Julian Eymard Church)
- Every Saturday after the 8:15am Mass until 1pm (or when reconciliation ends) with Closing Benediction (Queen of the Rosary Church)
