REFLECTIONS on being A SOWER


As we consider the parable of the sower, our focus usually turns to the things that have happened in our lives which resemble what happens to the seed. Seed falling on rocky ground reminds us of our faith being tested by failures, disappointment or loss. The randomness of evil makes us question why bad things happen to good people. Seed among thorns causes us to think of the distractions of the material world and how often worldly activities may compete with our Church attendance. With all of us undergoing the COVID-19 epidemic, health concerns and isolation have disrupted our normal routine and, for a time, prevented us from worshipping together on Sunday. The one thing we know with certainty is that weekly Mass attendance at OLBS is about half of what it was prior to the era of COVID.

What we need to recognize is that WE CAN BE THE SOWERS, individually and as a community. We can reach out to family members and friends. Most importantly, we need to be good listeners. We need to hear what difficulties exist which are preventing a return to weekly Mass. If there is something we can do to remove the obstacles, we should do so. We can at least let others know that we miss their attendance and participation on Sunday. We can offer positive comments on why the Mass makes a difference in our lives. Surveys indicate that most Catholics believe that the bread and wine used for Communion are symbols of the body and blood of Jesus Christ. Transubstantiation, the process by which bread and wine become the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist, is not known or understood. That is why Pope Francis is promoting Eucharistic Revival, reminding us that there is no substitute for reception of Holy Communion at Mass. Receiving Christ's body in person with prayer and reflection can make a difference in who we are and how we conduct our lives. Appreciating why Christ offers Himself to us at every celebration of the Mass is crucial. He can and will make a difference in our lives if we are open to accepting His gift of Himself.

We are all pilgrims together on this earthly journey. We can find ways to encourage others. We can help others to see how Jesus matters to us and wants to be loved by everyone.

If you can help even one person to believe as you do, YOU WILL TRULY BE THE SOWER OF SEED WHICH FALLS ON RICH SOIL TO YIELD A BOUNTIFUL HARVEST.




