

REFLECTION FROM TOTUS TUUS

The Totus Tuus program aims to inspire young people to long for holiness, develop a deep desire for conversion and personally renew their faith with a stronger prayer life. Totus Tuus uses sacred scripture and the catechism of the Catholic Church to instill the faith of the Church in the hearts and minds of young people. Each year, there is a focus on Marian devotion as well. Every day of the week the youth learn of another mystery and pray a decade of the rosary after recess as an entire group. By the end of the week, youth will have prayed an entire rosary and deepened their understanding of Christ's life through reflecting on the mysteries of the rosary. This year more than 70 OLBS students learned about the Mystery of Salvation and studied the Sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary. Please enjoy this recap of the week from one of our newest adult volunteers!

Hi, my name is David and I have been participating at Totus Tuus for more than 12 years. Starting in first grade my mom would take me to this weeklong Summer camp where I would learn about my faith and the Rosary, sing silly songs, see hilarious skits and go to daily Mass. When I entered 7th grade I started going to the evening program where I got to go to adoration and see the witnesses and hear the testimonies of the amazing college age missionaries who had taught me about the Ten Commandments and the Our Father when I was younger. Throughout

middle and high school I also got to volunteer in the day program where I helped kids in the classroom, cleaned up after meals and played with kids at recess. This year I have been blessed to be able to come back as an adult volunteer and see the kids and teens learning from the incredible missionaries all over again.

Totus Tuus really helped form me in the faith I have today. According to my mom, I was always very fidgety at Mass until one year at Totus Tuus when a missionary explained to me what and how important Mass is. Later on, when I was in the evening program, I was struck by the missionaries' joy no matter what was going on, and the love that they had for their faith. Because of the witness of the missionaries, I decided to go to Franciscan University, a very Catholic university, because I wanted to experience and share the joy that I saw in the missionaries who served me.

Because of all this I want to say thank you to everyone who has shared their time, money, food and home to help support this program, and I also want to thank everyone who brought their friends, kids and grandkids here! This program has changed my life and the lives of many other kids and I'm so glad that it is continuing to do so!



Discussion Questions


What would you do if you found a buried treasure? How can you respond to the treasure that Jesus died on the cross for you?






