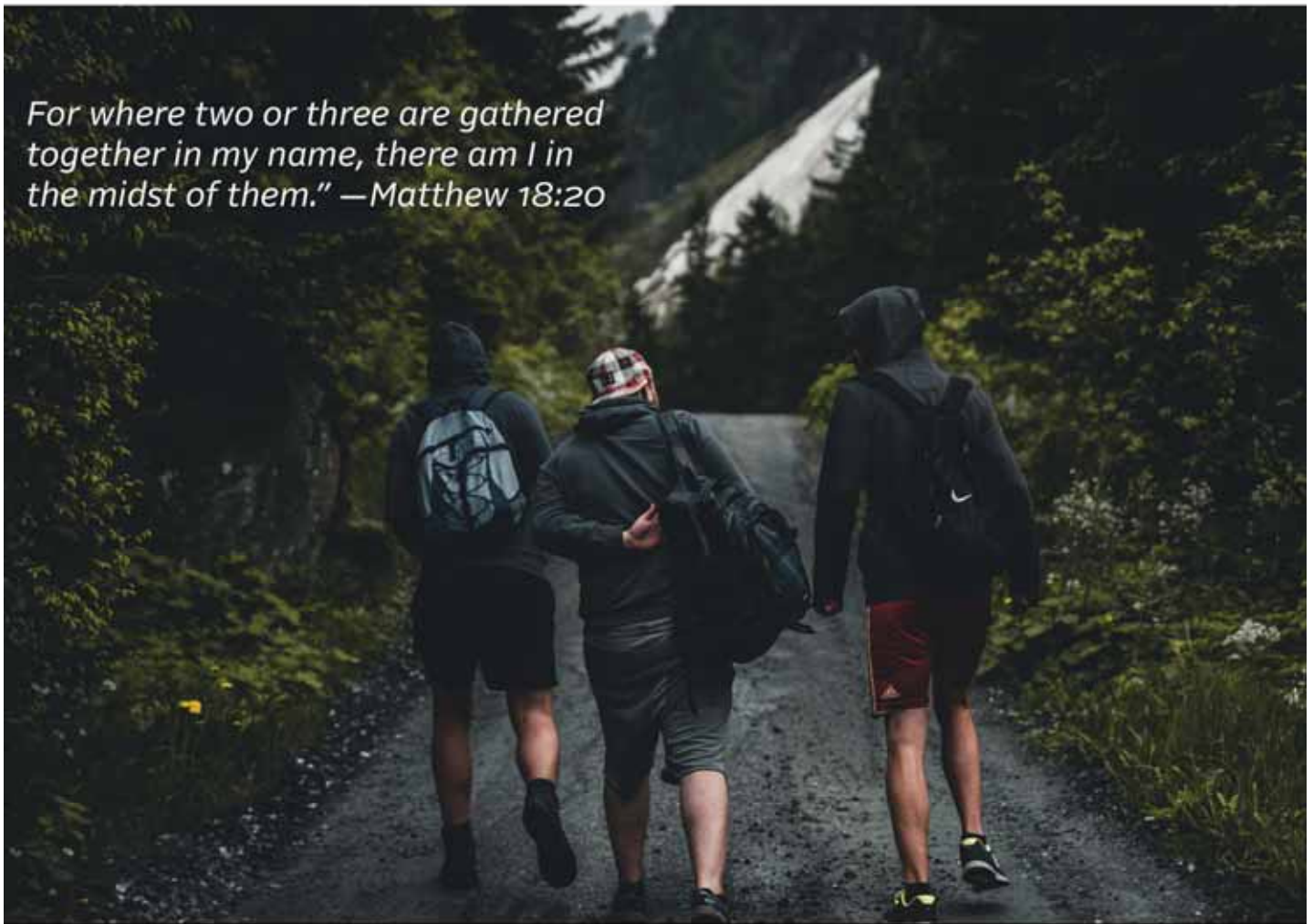

We are a people of brothers! (Matthew 18:15-20)

“If your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone.” My dear friends, the most important word is **“brother.”** A brother is part of the same family unit: father, mother, and children. In the Eastern world, all cousins belong to the same tribe. But for the Gospel, it is much more. This is the whole community of believers. On the day of our baptism, we became children of God. We have become brothers and sisters in Jesus Christ. We Christians are members of the same family of God called the Church meant to be the sacrament of love and unity.

Today’s Gospel shows us the way to get back a brother into the community of love and unity: we should go to see the sinner alone, then with some brothers. And if there is no result, we talk to the Church Community. **However, there is another danger that we must avoid:** we are not sent to our brother to correct him or to lecture him. We have much better things to do. To understand this, we are invited to look to Christ. Reading the gospels, we discover that he came to seek and save those who were lost. And today, he is counting on us to share his mission by helping each other to live as children of God. We know that this is not always an easy task. But the Lord sends us to others to witness his love for all of us. **Our mission is not only to rebuke the sinner but to show him the way that can save him.**

We must denounce or rebuke the evil and we know it well. **But we must not forget that the brother who has sinned is first and foremost a brother. He needs to be loved and cared for.** Through us, it is Jesus who is there to welcome, raise, and restore confidence in the sinner. It is obvious that to be faithful to this mission, we have a great need for the strength of the Holy Spirit. That is why the great witnesses of the faith began by spending long hours in prayer. Let us remember Saint Paul: **“It is no longer I who live, it is Christ who lives in me.”** (Galatians 2:20)

If we go to the brother who has sinned, it must always be with Christ in us, with great delicacy and love. We address this brother alone. It is not about to shame him in front of everyone. If the process fails, Christ invites us to act as the doctor who calls upon one or two colleagues. Some may be able to persuade the sinner better. If he refuses to listen to them, we will tell the community of the Church. The community of the faithful will do everything to carry him in its prayer and bring him back to God. If he refuses to listen to the community, consider him like a pagan and a publican. **This is not the final condemnation.** Jesus showed great concern for these people.

That brother who got out, we must **“get him back with us”**, we must save him. Let me tell you something very true: ***the power of the keys given to the Church is first and foremost a power of salvation.*** It is about opening the door so that the sinner can regain his place in the community. We all have a mission to make gestures of openness and welcome. The Gospel is first and foremost the Good News proclaimed to the poor, to the sick, and to excluded ones of all kinds. The Church has the power to bind but also to loose, to reintegrate the repentant sinner. **When a brother departs from the community, it is remembered in prayer.** Christ is present among those who are gathered in his name. He teaches us to adjust to God’s patience to bear witness to it throughout our lives. When we understand this, it changes everything in our lives.

Let us not forget that to “get back with him” all his brothers and sisters, Jesus gave himself to the very end, to the death on the cross. So today let us not harden our hearts but listen to the voice of the Lord. Let us pray on this day so that the Lord increases our faith in listening to your callings; may the Lord increase our trust in praying with one another; may the Lord increase our capacity to love, so that we may be agents of reconciliation in the divisions of the world. Amen. **God is good all the time...**



Ask about roses and thorns:

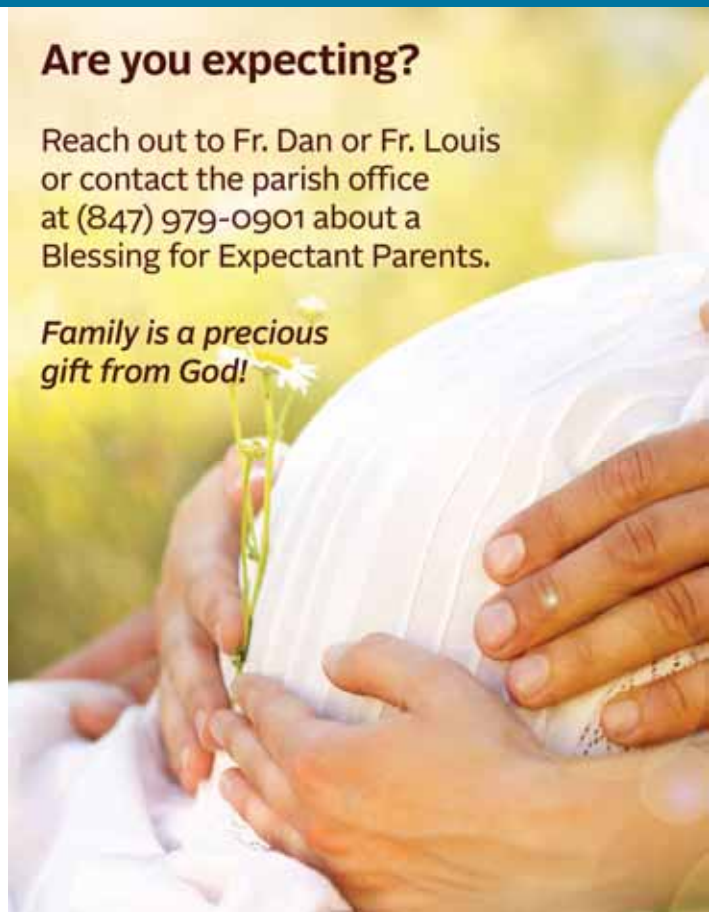
- What is a **rose** (a good thing) that happened today? Let's thank God for that.

Catholic Commentary on The Chosen Season 3

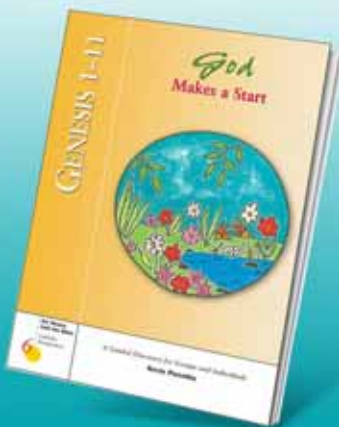
