A MESSAGE FROM FR. LOUIS ON THE HOLY FAMILY OF NAZARETH

God is good...As an extension of Christmas, we have reached the feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. The gospels tell us very little about them. Their purpose is not to satisfy our curiosity. The message they are sending us is indeed very important. What we need to look for is the good news that is being announced. This good news, it is up to us to welcome it, to make it pass in our life, and to communicate it around us.

Today we see Mary and Joseph going to the temple of Jerusalem to perform all that is prescribed by the law concerning the child. Formerly, the prophet Ezekiel had seen, in a grandiose vision, the glory of God come to the temple. He had heard this word: "*Son of man, this is the place of my throne, the place where I put the soles of my feet. I will live there among the Israelites forever.*" Now the Son of God is entering the temple of Jerusalem. He does it without glory and trumpet. The first to recognize this is not the official authorities, the scribes, and the priests, but small people. Through Simeon and Anna, the whole people of the poor come to meet Christ the Savior. This is a summary of the whole gospel.

This discovery was possible because Simeon and Anna were contemplatives. They served God days and nights in prayer. It is thanks to the inspiration of the Holy Spirit that Simeon recognizes in Jesus "**the salvation which God has prepared in sight of all the peoples, a light for revelation to the Gentiles and glory for his people Israel.**" Like Simeon and Anna, we can learn in prayer to recognize Christ in our lives. He is there, but too often we are elsewhere. We forget that to live Christmas is to first welcome Jesus who comes.

This meeting with Simeon and Anne leaves us with another message very important. Mary receives the revelation of the trials she will go through. This child will be a sign of division. His message will be rejected by most of his people. Salvation is offered to all, but nothing is possible if men/women do not let themselves be touched by the Light. Simeon predicts resistance among his people: This child will cause "**the fall and rise of many in Israel.**" The child will be "**a sign of division.**" Then Simeon adds to Mary's address: "**And you yourself a sword will pierce**" It is a way of announcing to Mary that she will feel more than anyone the drama of this rejection.

My dear friends, this is the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, a simple but deeply united family. This is where Jesus grew up. He will spend thirty years there. But one day he will give Mary and Joseph a surprising

revelation. He will tell them that he is also part of the Family of God who is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The whole Gospel wants to introduce us to this Family of God. Mary will have to make a difficult journey to adhere to this mysterious project of God on the child. Saint Luke does not tell us much about her or Jesus' childhood. But what he tells us is very important because he prepares us to hear and welcome the announcement of the good news to the poor.


It is in this perspective that we must situate our human families of today. They are the place where we grow up. This is where children normally receive the structuring values of love, spirituality, and faith. In many families, this mission is fulfilled with great generosity, and it is a pleasure to see. Unfortunately, this is not the case everywhere. Many couples break up, brothers and sisters remain angry for life, even at Christmas time. We are also thinking of families who are facing other very serious problems, unemployment, precariousness, over-indebtedness, illness...

Today's feast would like to encourage us to be apostles of the family so that we may be first and foremost a community of love and sharing, a source of peace, joy, and balance. This is where we learn mutual understanding, listening to each other, respect, forgiveness, service, and patience. We know that in every family life, there are difficult moments and painful trials. Life is a daily struggle against pride, selfishness, resentment... But in this challenge to be overcome, we are not alone, Christ is there. If we want, he will always be with us to teach us to be builders of peace, unity, and reconciliation. With him, the powers of evil will never prevail.

One last point: In reading this gospel, we must remember that we too have been presented to the Lord. It was on the day of our baptism. We were admitted into a great family called the Church. With all the members of this family, we are invited to gather around Christ our Savior. He never stops to come to us, but like Simeon and Anna, we can only recognize him if we have a poor heart. Let us open our hearts to the wonders of his love. Let us bless him for that grace which has incorporated us into him. If we want to, it is with him that 2024 will be a good year. **All the time God is good!!!**
