This Sunday, the Church recognizes **World Marriage Day** where the theme is “**Love Beyond Words**”.

The readings from this Sunday and World Marriage Day may not be directly related, but they are centered around the themes of **HEALING, CLEANSING and BELONGING**. The first reading from Leviticus talks about the purification process for people with skin diseases

St. Paul, in the second reading, reminds us that everything we do should be done for the glory of God, including our marriages. By putting God at the center of our marriages, we can ensure that our love for each other is pure and true. It is the spouses’ caring and loving behavior that brings healing and wellness in marriage. It is the calling of each spouse to take care of and heal each other; this calling allows us to experience God’s joyful grace, love and belonging—being part of the Holy Family.

In the Gospel, Jesus heals a leper by touching him, despite the social stigma—not belonging—at that time. Our Lord’s act of compassion and love is a powerful message for married couples. Spouses should be comfortable with the touch of their partner, and it should communicate love, intimacy, togetherness, and forgiveness—resulting in healing, cleansing and belonging. Married people should be able to communicate deeply through their bodies and experience God’s love and deep joy

Jesus communicates God’s love and mercy in signs that speak more eloquently than words. We celebrate World Marriage Day to proclaim the value of Marriage, a bond that is faithful, fruitful, and forever, not just to spouses and children, but all families, the Church, and the whole world. Pope Francis says—Marriage is a “Call to the Joy of Love... And Joy of the Church.”

As married spouses, we are invited to strive to better our relationship and make our families happy, healthy and Holy. May the Holy Family of Nazareth be our family model today and always, knowing that “the joy of the family is the joy of the Church”.

The theme for World Marriage Day 2024, “**Love Beyond Words,**” highlights the one-flesh union of husband and wife that is willed by God. It also indicates the personal self-gift of each spouse, one to the other. These concepts point to Christ who gives Himself, as real flesh and blood, under the appearance of bread and wine.

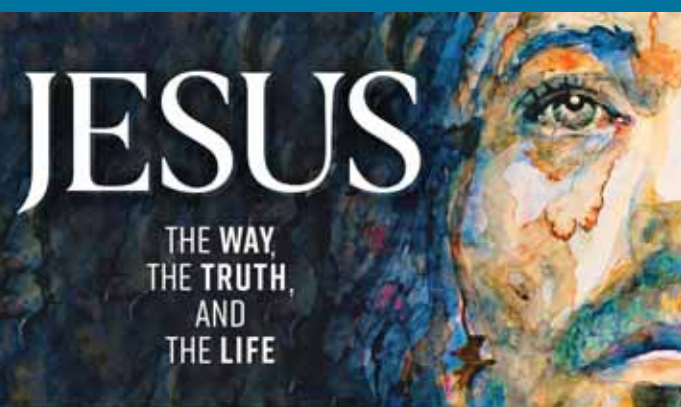

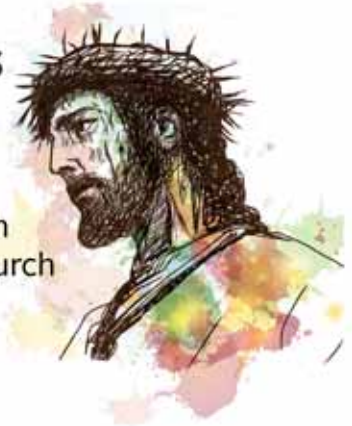
