Dear OLBS Family,

As we begin the sacred season of Lent, our hearts are called to draw closer to God through prayer, fasting and almsgiving. We are presented with a unique and meaningful opportunity to once again embody a spirit of compassion and generosity within our parish community. This Lenten season, our Parish Almsgiving Project takes us on a transformative journey to the heart of Nkoabang, Yaoundé, Cameroon.

Connecting Hearts Across Distance: Cameroon holds a special place in our hearts, as it is the birthplace of our beloved Associate Pastor, Fr. Louis Mboe. As we strive to grow closer to God through our Lenten practices, let us remember the power of almsgiving—an opportunity to extend our blessings to those in need. This Lent, we have the chance to connect our parish family with the community in Nkoabang, creating a bridge of compassion that transcends distance and borders. Our collective efforts will manifest in the construction of a hand-operated water pump and necessary access to ground water, addressing the fundamental need for clean water in Nkoabang.

A Call to Compassion & Action: Lent reminds us to reflect on our blessings and share them with those in need. This year, our focus is on **Waves of Change**, the Nkoabang Clean Water Project. This initiative goes beyond the borders of our parish to make a lasting impact on a community facing daily challenges due to the absence of safe, clean water. For us in the Chicagoland area, the thought of walking miles for water seems unthinkable. Our homes are seamlessly connected to the abundant and pure waters of Lake Michigan, providing a source of hydration and comfort at the twist of a faucet. But, currently, the people of Nkoabang fetch their water from a river, which is at some distance from their remote village, making the journey very challenging. Additionally, the river is not a safe water source, as it is also used for bathing and by animals.

A Journey of Hope: Imagine the impact of our parish coming together to bring a sustainable source of clean water to a community striving for a better life. **Waves of Change**, the Nkoabang Clean Water Project, is not simply a financial or physical endeavor; it is a journey of hope, a testament to our shared commitment to making a positive difference in the world.

How Can You Make a Difference?

1. **Prayer:** Keep the people of Nkoabang in your prayers throughout this Lenten season. May our efforts be guided by the Holy Spirit in compassion and love.
2. **Fasting:** Consider the people of Nkoabang, walking miles for water, as we fast and forego meat on Ash Wednesday and Fridays during Lent.
3. **Almsgiving:** Contribute to the project financially, as every donation, regardless of size, brings us closer to our goal of \$8500.
