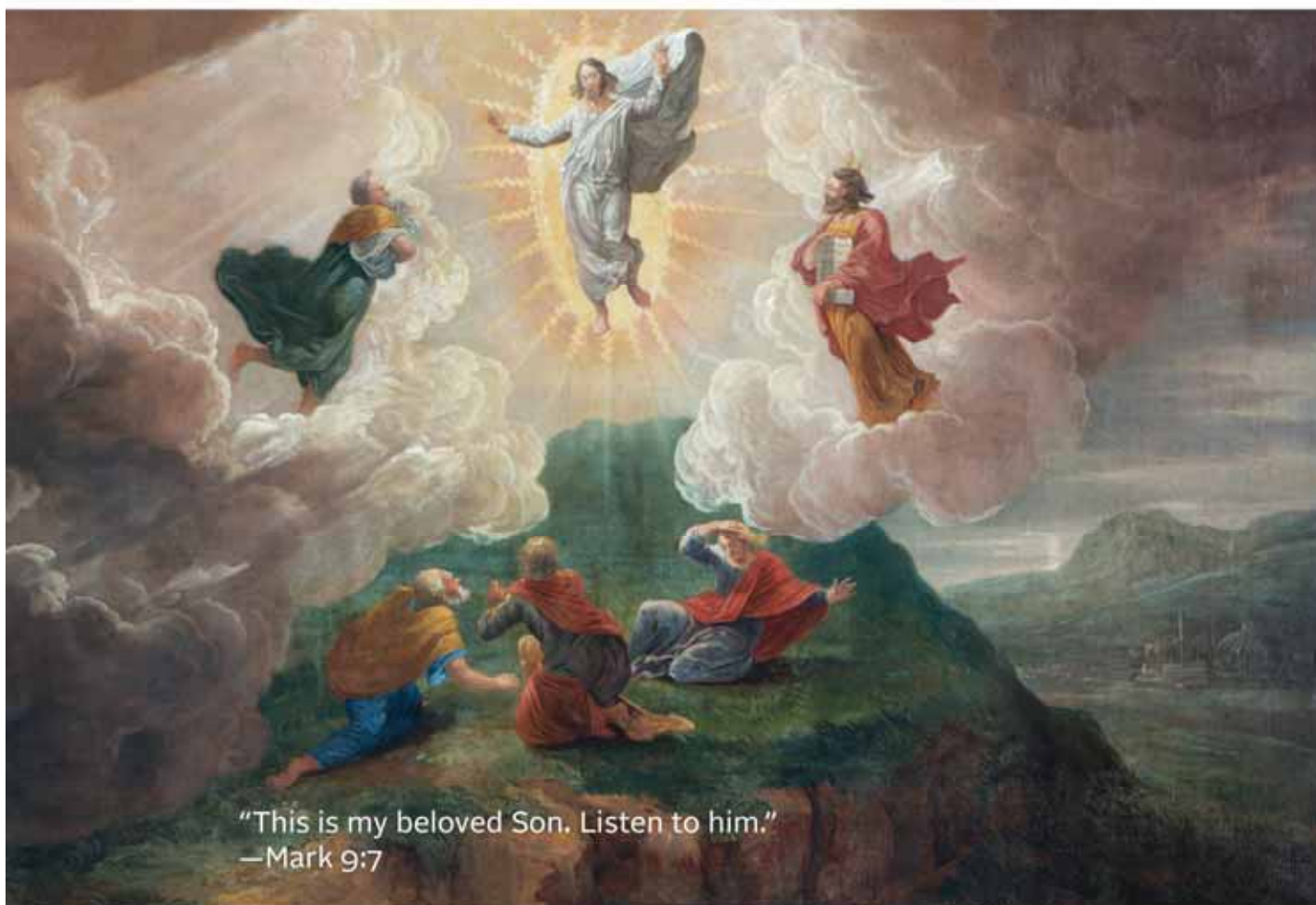

## OUR LENTEN JOURNEY

Much like Peter, James and John who witnessed the glorious transfiguration of Jesus on Mt. Tabor that we hear about in today's Gospel, we seek moments of divine encounter with our Lord. And during this parish year of the Eucharistic Revival, we are encouraged to find ways to weave the living presence of Jesus into the fabric of our parish life. The profound essence of our Catholic faith lies in the living, dynamic presence of our Lord and Savior actively at work in our lives today. But, in today's busy world, finding moments of peace and connection with Jesus is a precious gift. One way we foster this connection is through Eucharistic Adoration.

Eucharistic Adoration is a unique and enriching experience that allows us to deepen our relationship with Christ. By setting aside dedicated time to be in the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, we open ourselves to a multitude of spiritual gifts. One of the primary benefits is the opportunity for personal and communal prayer. During this quiet time, we can converse intimately with our Lord, pouring out our hopes, gratitude and even fears. This unhurried time of prayer fosters a sense of tranquility, providing solace in the midst of life's daily hustle.

Here at Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Parish, we are fortunate to offer several opportunities for Eucharistic Adoration. Beginning with the Mass of the day at 8:15am, we offer Adoration at St. Julian Eymard Church on Wednesdays until approximately 8:00pm. Saturdays offer another chance for Adoration, again starting with daily Mass at 8:15am and going until about 1:00pm at Queen of the Rosary Church. And on the First Friday of each month, Eucharistic Adoration begins with the 8:15am daily Mass at St. Julian Eymard Church and continues until 11:30am. These periods of Adoration are not merely activities, but sacred encounters with the living Christ, fulfilling the very heart of our parish's patroness. With these extended timeframes, we hope to accommodate various schedules, making Eucharistic Adoration accessible not just to those in our parish, but also those in the broader community seeking solace, spiritual nourishment and rejuvenation.

In addition, on Thursday mornings Adoration is specifically designated for students of our Queen of the Rosary School. By introducing our youngest minds to the practice of Eucharistic Adoration, we deepen the foundation of faith and encourage a lifelong habit of seeking solace in the presence of Christ. This experience

helps students develop a relationship with our risen Lord and a deeper understanding of the Eucharist's significance in their faith journey.

The benefits of Eucharistic Adoration extend beyond individual spiritual growth; Adoration fosters a sense of community within our parish. The shared experience of spending quiet time with our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament creates a bond among parishioners, reinforcing the unity of our parish. This shared spiritual practice promotes a sense of belonging, making the parish a true spiritual home for all in Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Parish and Queen of the Rosary School family.

Jesus Christ is an ever-present force, guiding, comforting and transforming the lives of believers. Our parish, with its commitment to providing ample opportunities for quiet communion with our Lord, exemplifies the transformative power of this practice. As we embrace these moments of serenity, we invite all members of our parish and school community to discover the profound joy and peace that comes from spending quiet time with our Lord in Eucharistic Adoration.





Lent is a time of spiritual renewal and self-discipline, providing us with the opportunity to draw closer to God through acts of sacrifice and prayer.

As we continue our Lenten journey, a quick reminder that fasting and abstaining from meat are integral to our spiritual journey. Apologies for any oversight, but let's be sure we're embracing this tradition together:

Catholics aged 18-59 and in reasonable health are required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This means that we can have one full meal and two smaller meals that, when combined, do not equal the size of the full meal. Additionally, Catholics 14 and older are required to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all Fridays during Lent.

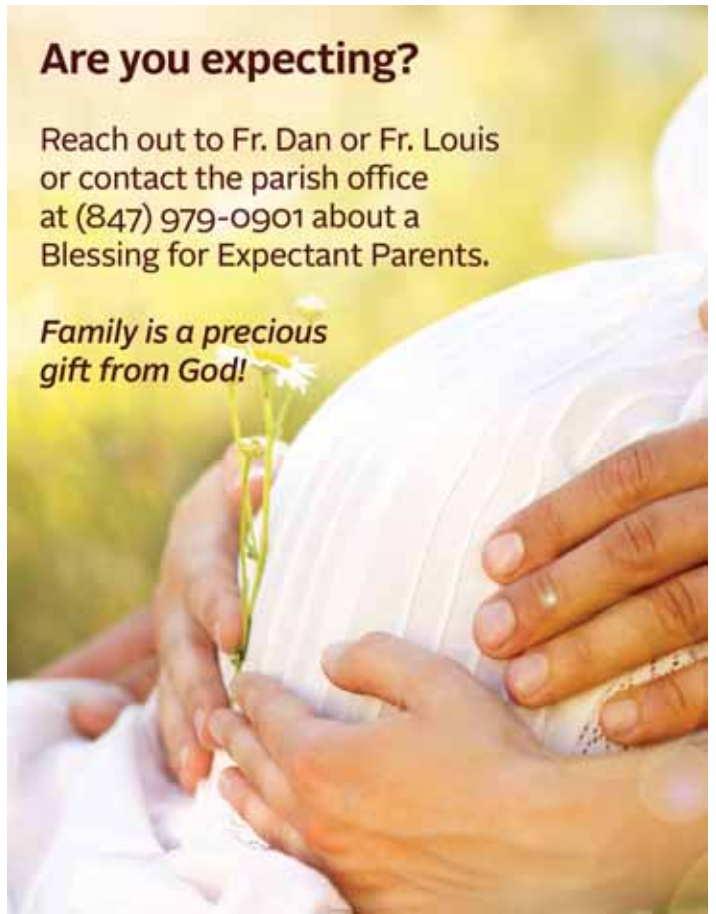

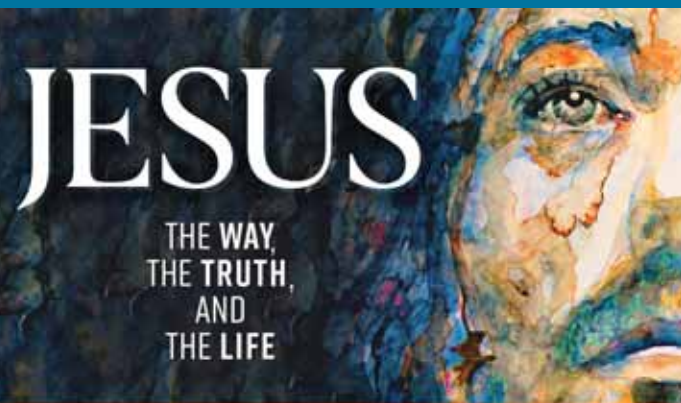
