My dear friends,

Today's liturgy makes us celebrate a feast that ends up in drama. Jesus goes up to Jerusalem; he is acclaimed by the crowd. But Jesus knows very well that this is his last ascent to this city. This is the hour when the Shepherd will give his life for his sheep. His followers will be scattered by his death. Many times, he had spoken to them about it. But for them, it was not possible. Then he will try to enlighten them and strengthen their faith. He is organizing a solemn entrance to Jerusalem. He walks, sitting on a donkey, like the shepherd amid his flock. The people acclaim him as a prophet, and he lets them do it.

**"Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord..."** This joyful crowd was right. Jesus is truly God's messenger. But that is another way he will take a few days later. Instead of going to the temple of Jerusalem, he will go up to Calvary. He will no longer be there as a king among his subjects but as a criminal condemned to the most humiliating death, the one reserved for criminals and terrorists. He will have to bear his cross, a heavy cross of all our sins. Pilate will place an inscription above his head: **"Jesus of Nazareth, king of the Jews."** He did not think he was saying so well: Jesus is King, not only of the Jews but also of the whole universe.

My dear friends, throughout this holy week, we are invited to follow Jesus on the way to Calvary. We will turn our gaze to this cross that reminds us of how much God loved us. **(LOVE STRONGER THAN DEATH)** We will remember this word of the gospel:

**"Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends."** (John 15:13) We are a bit too used to the cross of Christ. But for Paul before his conversion, it was unimaginable.

Christ gave his life on the cross for the salvation of the world. Let us think about this: When someone is sick and half unconscious, the only way to save this person is an I.V. Our sick world also needs an I.V of love. That is what will happen during Holy Week. Christ descended to the depths of our despair to deposit this love that comes from God. Beyond night, he gave birth to a new day. From now on, there is no darkness beyond his presence. Together with all Christians throughout the world, we raise the same prayer as we said: **"You who are Light, you who are love, put in our darkness your Spirit of love."** God is good all the time...
