Recently I have been watching the television series "Masters of the Air". It is based on the experiences of the 100th Bomb Group of the United States Army Air Force during the Second World War. As some of the pilots were shot down on their missions and captured, they were sometimes brought to prisoner-of-war camps within Germany.

One of the scenes towards the end of the series depicts the POWs realizing that the airplanes flying over the camp one day are Allied. It has been nearly a year since the invasion of Europe on D-Day. Some of them have been in captivity for even longer than that. They have managed to survive the meager rations, the forced marches, and much worse. They begin celebrating and cheering as it dawns on them: finally, their freedom and liberation is at hand.

Their sense of relief and joy jumps off the screen and fills every corner of my own heart as I watch it. How beautiful it is to witness the fulfillment of the hope for which they had been so desperately longing! They had not been forgotten. They would not be left behind.

Friends, is this not the story of Easter? On His Cross, has not God Himself launched an invasion into the kingdoms of Sin and Death, so that He might set us free? The story is in fact even more wonderful for us because we did not deserve it. We ourselves chose to live as slaves to Sin and Death, but our God has come anyway! "Christ is risen from the dead, trampling down Death by death, and upon those in the tombs bestowing life!" He has not forgotten us. He does not want to leave us behind.

The great sadness of our life is that, sometimes, we ourselves desire to be left behind. We think that our sins are the whole of our story, and that we cannot possibly be freed from them. We become so focused on the walls of the prison we have built that we allow ourselves to forget: our God is mighty, He is unconquerable, and He will always come for us.

As He says through the prophet Isaiah: "Even to your old age I am He, even when your hair is gray I will carry you; I have done this, and I will lift you up, I will carry you to safety. To whom would you liken me as an equal, compare me, as though we were alike?"

Jesus is Lord. He has no rivals. There is no power that can contend with His love.

May you know and live in the power of His love this day, and every day to come.

Happy Easter! He is risen, as He promised!

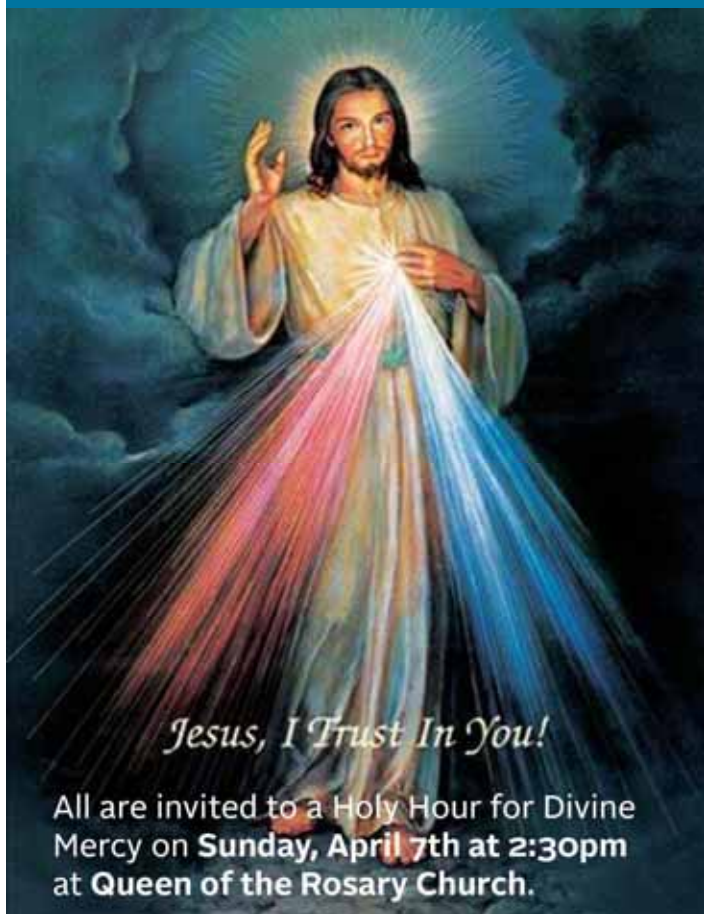

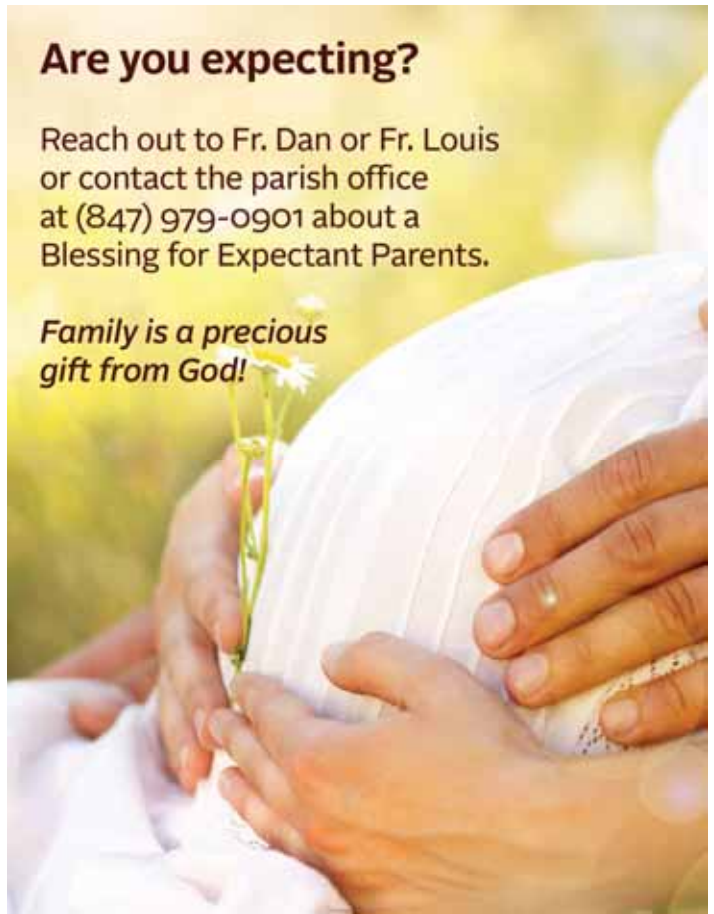
