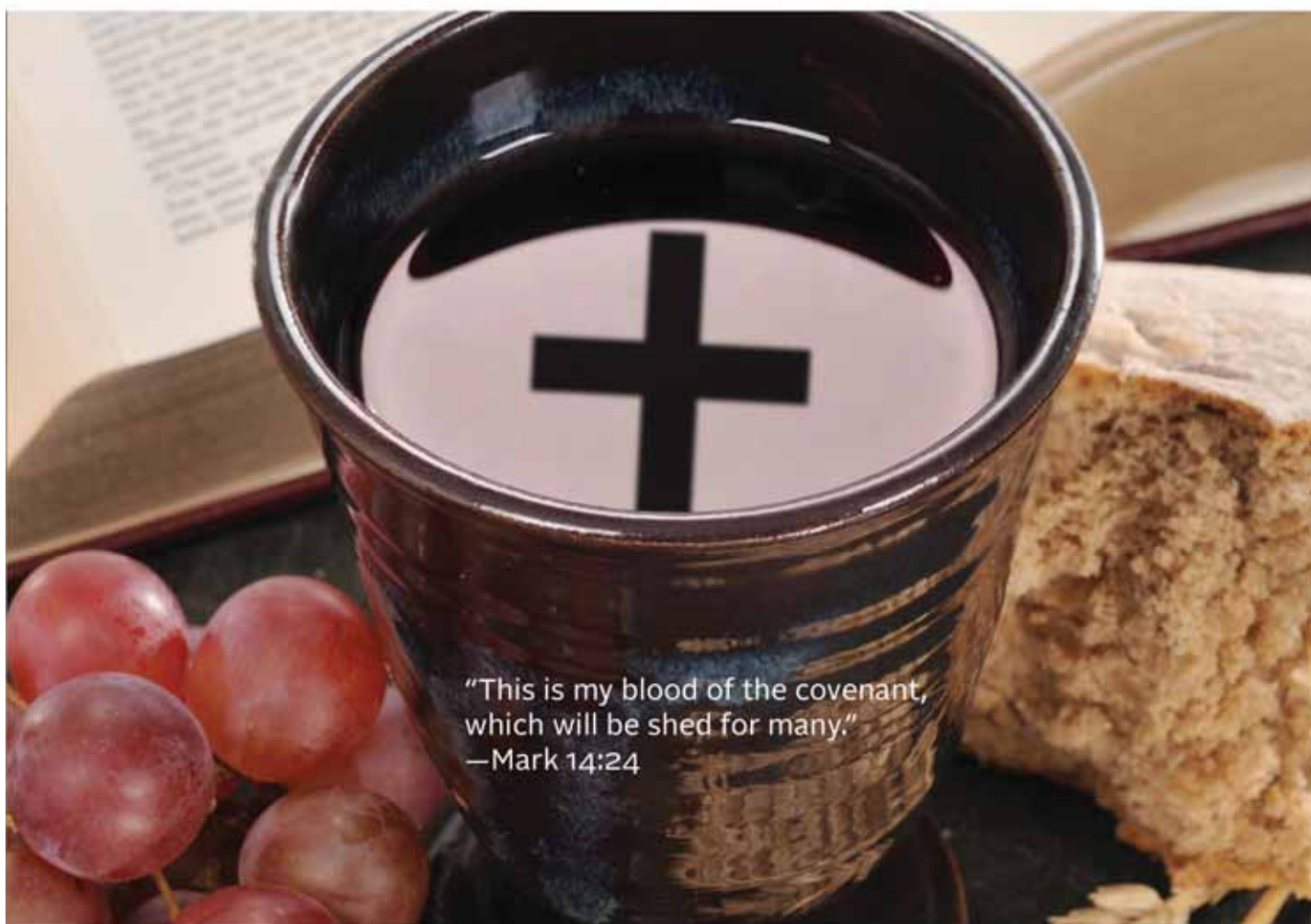

My thanks to everyone for your well-wishes on my 10 year anniversary of ordination to the priesthood. I hope that every year, I am learning and growing in what it means to be a parish priest and a pastor, and I am grateful for all of you as we walk the Christian journey together. What a gift also that Fr. Louis and Ms. McGinn have been to me these last four years. I can never say “thank you” enough for their hard work, their dedication, their example, their witness, and their friendship. I know as we all prepare for their transitions, you will continue to join me in gratitude and prayers for them.

Early bulletin deadlines around Memorial Day pose an interesting challenge: there are some things that I want to write to inform you about, but I am not yet able to give more details in this space. As I write this, it is Tuesday, May 21. God willing, by the time you read this on June 1 or 2, we will have been able to give more details and this little article will be out of date!

In the last couple of months, the parish staff and I had a chance to meet with a few priests as part of the associate pastor placement process. Again, as I write this I do not think I can share anything more officially, but I do believe that the priest who should be coming here will be a good fit in our parish community and I look forward to working alongside him.

I am also very grateful for the work of the principal interview committee members who have helped me to make a decision about the direction of our Queen of the Rosary School. Their experience and input have been invaluable, and—again—by the time you are reading this I am hopeful that we have already been able to announce our new principal!

Many of you already know that the last couple of years, the conversations with the Elk Grove Park District about the use of the parking lot at Queen of the Rosary have unfortunately not borne any fruit.

As such, in order to be good stewards of our property and resources, we have contracted with a towing company to assist us. You should see their signs up around the parking lot entrances. Please know that this is not an issue about money—it has to do with liability and insurance, and neither one of our providers is able to carry the risk for the other.

Finally, my thanks to all who have contributed toward our Annual Catholic Appeal goal. As I write this, our pledged amount has surpassed our goal by about \$6000. The work on the bathrooms at St. Julian will cost about \$5000, and the work at Queen of the Rosary will be more than that. For the 210 donors who have already made their gift, my thanks for helping us reach this goal! To those who have not yet made a contribution to the Appeal, please consider helping us with this work.

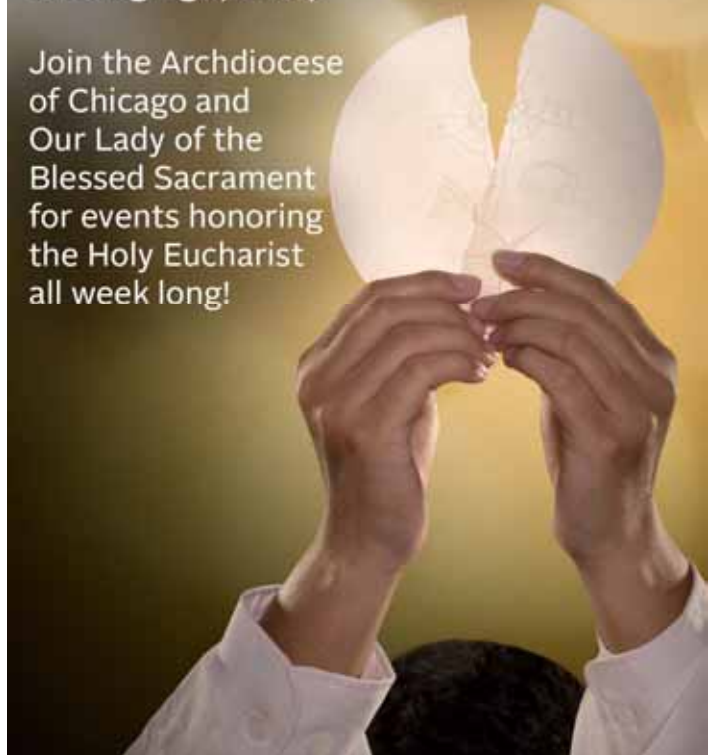
