With May dedicated to honoring the Blessed Virgin Mary, Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Parish is preparing to celebrate this month and her Feast Day with a multitude of Marian devotions. See below for small, daily offerings to our blessed Mother that we can each undertake, as we unite in love and reverence for our patroness. Let us offer to our Mother...

May 1. Brief but frequent prayers of love, such as: "Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament, pray for us. Your petitions are most powerful."

May 2. Many glances of affection and many words of love, when we see her image or picture in our home, in the church, or anywhere. (*Note for children ages 12 and younger, ask a parent or guardian to help you and e-mail us at info@olbseqv.org with a list of five places you see an image or statue of Mary in our parish. The first three correct entries will receive a special Rosary. Be sure to tell us your name and age!*)

May 3. "Hail Mary" every hour.

May 4. A loving review of her life with Jesus, as we recite the Joyful Mysteries of the Rosary. (*May 4th is First Saturday, join us for the 8:15am Mass and stay afterward to pray the First Saturday Rosary; QR.*)

May 5. The renewal of our baptismal vows.

May 6. The Angelus recited punctually at noon and with great affection.

May 7. Affectionate details of service and attention to those closest to us.

May 8. The effort of doing our ordinary work well, on time, with competence and finesse.

May 9. Small hidden sacrifices, especially those that go against the grain.

May 10. Spend time with our Blessed Mother in one of our Marian Gardens. (*Located behind the old parish center, QR; and on the East side of church, SJE.*)

May 11 Visit to a poor person to communicate our Lady's concern for that person. (*Alternately, you may choose to donate an item on the Wish List for Season for Life or our Good Samaritans, or to sign up for the end of May Summer Supper or June 29th Morning of Service.*)

May 12

A visit to a lonely person to share the joy of trusting in God alone.

May 13. Jesus himself, when we receive him in holy Communion. (*Mass on the Feast of Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament will be offered at 8:15am; SJE.*)

May 14. Prompt obedience, when we are called or asked to do some errand or some act of service.

May 15. A good, sincere, sorrowful confession of our sins and failures, in the sacrament of Penance. (*Reconciliation is scheduled at 7:00pm; SJE.*)

May 16. An act of contrition, said many times, asking our Mother to offer our sorrow for our sins to Jesus crucified.

May 17. The mortification of keeping quiet about any pain or discomfort, any inconvenience or disappointment, uniting it with our Mother's pain as she stood by her crucified Son.

May 18. Five small hidden sacrifices in honor of the five major wounds of our Lord.

May 19. The "Memorare" for the person in our family who most needs the help of our Lady.

May 20. A smile when we do not feel like smiling.

May 21. The prayer "Blessed be your purity"

May 22. A visit to Jesus truly present in the Blessed Sacrament. (*Adoration begins with morning Mass at 8:15am and continues until Closing Benediction and Reposition when Reconciliation concludes at approximately 8:00pm; SJE.*)

May 23. A kind word, a friendly conversation, a helping hand to persons with whom we live or work.

May 24. In addition to the mysteries of the day, one more part (five decades) of the Holy Rosary.

May 25. Many affectionate thoughts and prayers, by saying "Mary, my mother" each time we pause in our work.

May 26. Teaching someone how to say the Holy Rosary. (*If you need a Rosary or instructions on praying the Rosary, please drop by the parish office.*)

May 27. The resolution to say, before going to sleep every night, three Hail Marys.

May 28. The Holy Rosary said with concentration and affection. (*Join Rosary Ministry to pray the Rosary each Tuesday at 7:00pm; SJE.*)

May 29. The "Hail Holy Queen" at each hour.

May 30. A visit or a conversation with a friend or relative whom we want to encourage to go to come back to the Church.

May 31. A smile when someone corrects us or misjudges us.

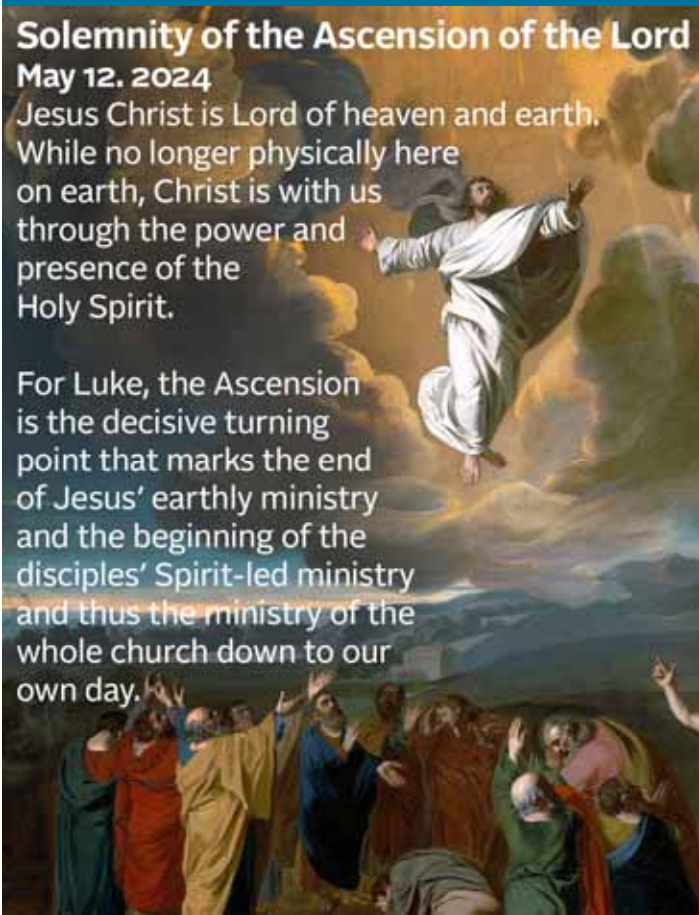


Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord

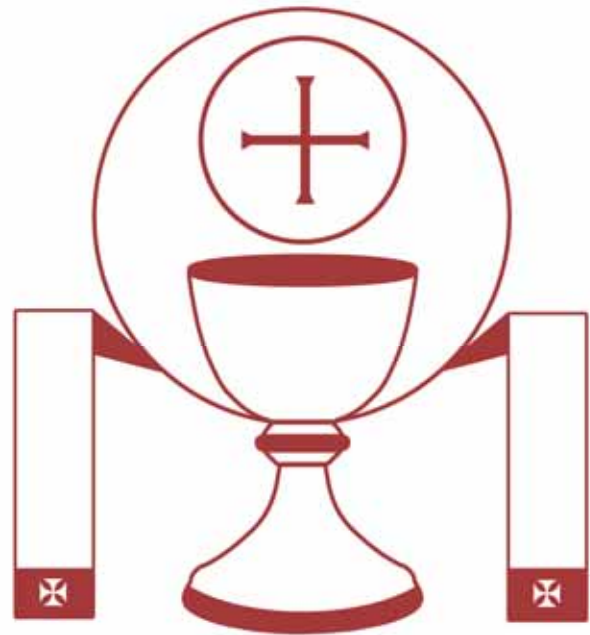
May 12, 2024

Before Jesus is arrested, He prays to the Father to guard and protect His disciples. *"I speak this in the world so that they may share my joy completely."* — John 17:13



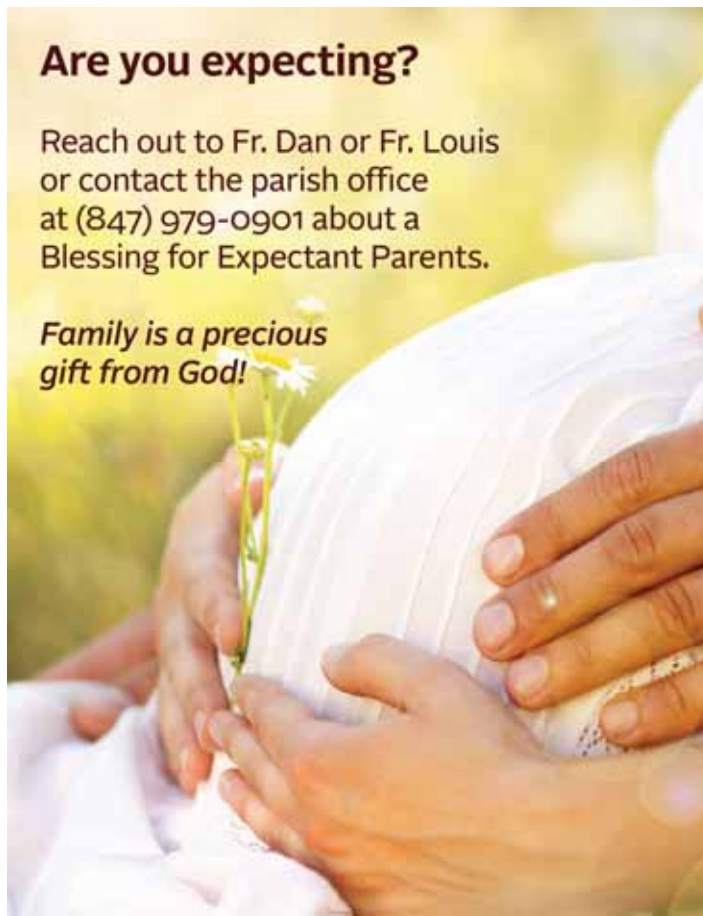
