What are Mass Times and Office Hours?

Daily: 8:15am St. Julian Eymard Mon/Wed/Fri; 8:15am Queen of the Rosary Tue/Thu/Sat

Sunday: Sat 5pm Vigil and Sun 9:15am St. Julian Eymard;

Sun 8am and 10:30am Queen of the Rosary

Reconciliation: Wed 7pm St. Julian Eymard; Sat Noon Queen of the Rosary

Office Hours: 10am to 5pm Mon - Fri at St. Julian Eymard

How many locations do you have?

We have two worship sites in Elk Grove Village, Queen of the Rosary Church and St. Julian Eymard Church, plus the parish school Queen of the Rosary School. See "Our Locations" for addresses.

Where do I park?

There is on-site parking adjacent to both worship sites. While Elk Grove Village is a safe neighborhood, please be aware that parking lots are not secured or monitored.

Do you have an accessible entrance for my wheelchair/walker/other?

At Queen of the Rosary Church there is an accessible ramp at the main entrance on the South side of the church. At St. Julian Eymard Church, the accessible entrance is at the walkway on the East side of the church.

What is the dress code?

On any given Sunday, we see everything from jeans and tees to Sunday best. Dress for comfort, and the weather.

What about my kids?

We welcome children to worship and fellowship and have many activities geared toward children including "Activity Bags" to keep little ones occupied and learning. See "Got Kids" for more information.
