## MEET OUR NEW ASSOCIATE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners of Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament, Let me start by saying that I am very happy to be here with you all and serve as your Associate Pastor. I also ask for your prayers that my ministry among you will further the presence and love of God.

I was born on March 12, 1981, not in a hospital (so no one knows how much I weighed at birth) but in my grandfather's house. My grandfather was the midwife. I was born and bred in Nigeria, a country I remain very proud of. I am from the Southwestern part of the country and by ethnicity, I am Yorùbá. The Yorùbás in Nigeria are known more for being intellectually inclined and party-makers. I am from a family of 9. My mother is still alive, and you will hear a lot about her in my sermons. My father died about 20 years ago.

After my seminary formation in Nigeria, I was ordained for the Diocese of Èkìtì, and I spent my first four years as a priest as the Diocesan and Bishop's Secretary dealing mostly with files. In 2013, I was privileged to be asked to come for Studies in the States by my Bishop. After my studies, my Bishop, Bishop Felix Fémi Àjákáyé thought it helpful for me work for some time in the Archdiocese of Chicago mainly because my then parish, St Peter's Skokie was very helpful for my diocese.

I love studying and talking about the Bible. People say my homily can be shorter, but it is never as long as Jesus's sermon on the mount. I also love the real football. I play football but as you can see, I never made it to the professional level. I also love reading. I read any genre except horror books. I enjoy good music and I can dance, if given the opportunity.

I am grateful to Frs Dan and Louis for the welcome they have given me. I pray for God's wisdom and guidance for Fr Louis. As I get to know you all, all I ask for again is your prayers that I am in your midst as a Priest after the Heart of Jesus.

## DID YOU KNOW?

The word *liturgy* comes from the Greek word leitourgia, which can be broken down to two words: *laos*, meaning “people,” and *ergon*, meaning “work.” Liturgy literally means “work of the people.” In ancient Greece, the word *leitourgia* was used to mean any work that was done in service for the good of the people. So from the beginning, liturgy has been connected to work.

My brother and I didn’t need alarm clocks to wake us in the morning. Our mother’s morning ritual was all we needed. Before the sun rose and before the birds chirped through their morning concert, she would walk in and say, “Come on, get up, there’s work to be done.”

Mom wasn’t one to rest. She was up at 6:00am every day—even on weekends—even on vacation. With two children, a house, a dog and a yard to tend, much had to be done.

For Mom, work was a prime motivator. She didn’t have to punch a clock. She didn’t have a boss. She didn’t have to report to anyone. It was the work itself that prompted her to get out of bed in the morning. Mom often attended daily Mass. She instinctively knew that liturgy and labor went hand in hand.

It takes a lot of human labor to make liturgy. There is the work we see: the ministers who prepare and serve as reader, musicians, altar servers, and so on, but more work is done behind the scenes. Farmers grow the wheat and the grapes for the bread and the wine that are consecrated, and distributors, drivers and countless others ensure our ready supply of bread and wine. Many labor to cut and cast the vessels that hold the Body and Blood of Christ, and manufacturers make the fabric, and seamstresses the altar linens and vestments. Gardeners and beekeepers provide our beeswax candles and so on.

The assembly’s act of participation in the liturgy is itself an act of labor as they listen to the Word of God and seek to understand how God is calling them to act. In the midst of worship, the faithful process to the altar with the gifts of bread and wine, the “work of human hands.” In this procession worshippers bring the gift of themselves—their hopes and dreams, their cares and their struggles to the altar. Their lives, along with the bread and wine, are transformed by the work of praying the Eucharistic Prayer.

In that prayer are active verbs such as *offer*, *give thanks*, *remember* and *pray*—all of which call the faithful to the work of transforming not just themselves, but the world. The liturgy concludes with an instruction as the priest or deacon says, “Go forth, the Mass is ended,” “Go and announce the Gospel of the Lord,” “Go in peace, glorifying the Lord by your life,” or “Go in peace.” The faithful are sent forth to do their work in the world—bringing God’s presence to their families, workplaces and communities.




