

As we begin our fifth year as Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Parish, I want to provide a kind of “roadmap” for some important milestones that we will experience together in the coming years. As a reminder, here are some highlights of our journey since 2020:

Our first two years as Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament might best be described as heeding Jesus’ call to disciples to “get into the boat” (Mark 6:45). Though we successfully unified our parish staff and office, bulletin and website, we were coming out of COVID protocols and getting acquainted with our new companions on the journey. We made significant progress unifying Mass schedules, leadership councils and ministries in these first years as Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Parish.

In 2022, the story of Zacchaeus the Tax Collector from the Gospel of Luke served as the foundation of our year of Healing, Hope and Hospitality. Helping us on this journey was the ability to gather for worship and fellowship without restriction. We saw attendance at daily and Sunday Mass slowly increase. We saw strong participation from our parish and school for a variety of celebrations. Our Bereavement Ministry united the celebration of our annual All Souls Mass, and ministers formed a Grief Share Group, Journey of the Heart, to bring healing to the bereaved. Ministers of Care helped launch the Little Flower Ministry to bring hope to our homebound, and Fr. Louis and I began making visits to the homebound during Lent and Advent, bringing the healing presence of Jesus with a seasonal flower. Grounds & Garden installed new landscaping at both worship sites, creating welcoming entrances.

Last year we introduced the theme of Be Transformed. We have seen many examples of transformation, both large and small. Perhaps the most visible is the re-imagining of the vestibules at both of our worship sites, including installation of Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament statues. We expanded opportunities for Adoration to include a full day on Wednesday and half a day on Saturday. Our leadership councils grew, and ministries began to make use of the GIFT Fund to energize their efforts. We participated in the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage, visiting the pilgrimage at its stop at the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe and hosting a Morning of Adoration and Service.

This year we are continuing with the theme of Be Transformed, so that God’s desire for us to be renewed can more deeply sink into our hearts, and we will focus on the work of evangelization and helping people discern their charisms. Each one of us is called to be transformed by the power, the grace, the goodness, the mercy, the love of God, so that we can fulfill the mission He has given to each one of us. We want to build a culture where everyone can experience the power of the Gospel and find the place where they belong.

Working from these foundations, next year (in the fall of 2025) we will begin our Multi-Site Review Process. This picks up from our original decree of unification, which asked us to take some time and discern together how to best proceed with our campuses and our buildings. This process will take about 3-4 months, and will include several parish-wide information sessions and regular updates on how the conversations are progressing. I want to again stress, as I have always said, that no one is making this decision for us. We are the ones who must decide what makes sense for our future.

I expect that in January of 2026, we will begin our wave of the new archdiocesan capital campaign. This new campaign is “Generation to Generation: Answer the Call”. There are several needs to be addressed by this new campaign, but one of the primary focuses is to make sure that we have the necessary resources to care for the health and well-being of our active and retired priests. The pilot phase of this campaign is already underway. I have asked that our parish be placed in a wave in the second half of the campaign, so that we might have time to make a determination about our parish and campuses first before we engage in a major fundraising effort.




**Join the Handbell Choir**




**Tuesday Morning Scripture Discussion**
