

# Twenty-ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time | October 20, 2024

Under Mary's mantle, and with the guidance of the Holy Trinity, Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament seeks to share God's love by celebrating the sacraments, proclaiming the gospel, and serving the needs of all His children.

Dear Parish Family,

I want to provide you with an update on the electrical repairs at St. Julian Eymard Church. Shortly after this issue presented itself on Wednesday, October 9th, we discovered that this was more than a run of the mill power outage. Back in the 1980s when the 10-room addition was added to St. Julian Eymard Church, it was built over an existing, unshielded, electrical cable which brings power to the church. Pressure from the building led to the breach of the cable. The repair to fix this issue requires burying a new cable from the electrical main on Biesterfield Road to the church's transformer.

As faithful stewards of our resources, we are obtaining competitive estimates for this work. We expect to have all estimates in hand and a vendor selected by the time this bulletin goes to press. Once a contractor is chosen, the repair work is expected to take several days to complete. During this time, St. Julian Eymard Church will need to remain closed for Mass, Ministry and events, and we will continue to update you on progress and our parish calendar.

We are blessed to have a second location and will continue to use our Queen of the Rosary Church and School to relocate most, if not all, of our events. Our office manager, Mary McKenzie, has set up a temporary office at Queen of the Rosary School and is maintaining normal parish business hours, while most of our staff continues to work remotely. Fr. Paul and I continue to be

available by appointment, and we are responding promptly to telephone and email inquiries.

As always, I remain committed to transparency. 




