Under Mary's mantle, and with the guidance of the Holy Trinity, Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament seeks to share God's love by celebrating the sacraments, proclaiming the gospel, and serving the needs of all His children.

As we approach the Advent season and a new liturgical year, this Sunday we hear how Jesus honors the poor widow who gives her last two coins to the Temple treasury (Mark 12:38-44). Her offering, though small, comes from her heart and is given with great faith. Like the widow, we are called to give what we can to build up the Kingdom of God—not only from our treasure, but also through our time, talent and invitation to others.

In this spirit, Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Parish invites you to participate in **Pray. Invite. Bring.** An initiative aimed at sharing our gift of faith and inviting others to encounter our Lord.

While parish promotions—bulletin, newsletters, websites, flyers, announcements and the like—help to create awareness, studies show that the most effective way to increase attendance and participation is through personal invitation.

According to surveys by Religion in American Life, only 2% or 3% of people attend church because of advertising, while 85% come after being invited by a friend or family member. Further, a Study by Church Trainer Group reveals:

- 1-2% Were Evangelized
- 2-3% Liked a program offered
- 3-4% Had a need met by the church or were attracted by Sunday School
- 6-8% Walked in by their own initiative
- 8-10% Liked the pastor
- 70-85% Were invited by a relative or friend!

But it's not just modern research—we have clear evidence of this from Jesus Himself. How did Jesus invite the Apostles? He didn't put up billboards, hire skywriters or send out stone tablets. He personally invited them, saying, "Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men." (Matthew 4:19). This personal invitation changed their lives—and continues to change the world.

And Jesus didn't stop with the Apostles. He extended that mission to all of us as His disciples when He commissioned disciples to "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations" (Matthew 28:19). His call to invite others is not just for the Apostles, but for each one of us.

Here's how you can join the mission:

Pray: As Fr. Dan has shared before, let God do the heavy lifting. Through prayer, we find strength and consolation in Jesus' words and in His continuing presence with us. Ask God to open your heart and guide you to someone who may need an invitation to connect, or reconnect, with Him. Write their name(s) on an intention card and place the card in the offertory baskets when they come around. Cards will be separated out and placed in baskets in front of the altar at Queen of the Rosary and St. Julian Eymard Churches and will remain there until the First Sunday of Advent. You may add intention cards at any time.

Invite: Personally reach out to the friend, family member or neighbor you wrote on the intention card to attend Mass or a parish event over Advent and Christmas. Please use any of the parish's promotional materials to help in your efforts, but remember that a heartfelt invitation will have the most profound impact!

Bring: Offer to attend with them. Whether it's Mass, a parish event or a ministry gathering, your presence will help make those you invite feel welcome and supported.

Just as the widow's humble offering created a lasting impression, our personal invitations can create a ripple effect of faith and community. Together, we can help others experience the joy of a personal relationship with Christ. We never know how lives will change when we take the time to invite someone to encounter Jesus
