PARISH OUTREACH UPDATE

This weekend's second collection for the Catholic Campaign for Human Development (CCHD) reminds us that, like the organizations supported by CCHD, we too are "working on the margins." Organizations supported by CCHD must meet certain criteria and are carefully vetted to ensure integrity and impact. Though our parish outreach is not a direct beneficiary, we stand united in Christ's mission. Inspired by this Sunday's Gospel from Mark, we respond to His call to shine light in dark places and bring hope where it's needed most. Read more from our parish representative to the Interfaith Council and coordinator of the Welcome the Stranger Ministry.

My name is Don Kauffold, a parishioner at Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament. Over the last few years, I have been representing OLBS on the Elk Grove Interfaith Council. The Interfaith Council consists of representatives from various faith communities, local government, and social service organizations in EGV. Our goal is to work as a team to better serve the spiritual and physical needs of the citizens of Elk Grove and surrounding communities.

Our recent focus on the need for more affordable housing in Elk Grove helped initiate a proposal for a new 30-unit affordable rental independent living community for seniors at 750 S. Arlington Heights Road. Village leadership is considering this proposal from the Housing Opportunity Development Corporation (HODC) which is a community-based nonprofit developer with a history of building beautiful, affordable housing in the Northern and Northwestern Chicago suburbs. The EGV Planning Commission will review the petition from HODC at a public meeting on Monday, November 18 at 7:00 p.m. The petition is currently available for review on the EGV website at Home/Government/Agenda & Public Meetings/Plan Commission Hearing.

Another worthwhile interfaith effort to help those struggling with housing is the Elk Grove PADs homeless shelter that is hosted by Christus Victor Lutheran Church, 1045 S Arlington Heights Road. PADS is an acronym for Public Action to Deliver Shelter. The Elk Grove PADS shelter is open every Sunday evening/ Monday morning from October through April. Each Sunday, guests start checking-in at 6:45 PM and leave the facility by 7:00 AM. Guests are provided with a hot dinner, a safe, comfortable place to sleep for the evening, a continental breakfast in the morning, and a sack lunch. The shelter also provides guests with winter coats, hats, and gloves and personal care items like shampoo, toothpaste, disposable razors, etc.

The Elk Grove PADS shelter has been welcoming 30-40 guests each Sunday since the season started in October. This year, the shelter is welcoming families as well as adult men and women. Because many families struggle to cover monthly living costs, large unexpected costs can upset their finances to the point of losing their homes. Unfortunately, the number of young families in need of shelter is growing.

Volunteers work in shifts to manage the shelter through the evening:

- Food donations are dropped off at the shelter between 5:00-6:00 PM each Sunday afternoon.
- The kitchen team works from 5:30-8:00 PM to prepare and serve a hot dinner to the guests and clean up afterwards.
- 1st Shift: 6:00 11:00 PM: Open the shelter, prepare the sleeping rooms setting up the mats and linens, welcome and register the guests, share a meal with them, and manage the shelter.
- 2nd Shift: 11:00 PM 3:00 AM: Staff the shelter during the late shift monitoring the shelter and preparing brown bag lunches.
- 3rd Shift: 3:00 7:00 AM: Staff the shelter during the early morning shift monitoring the shelter, making wake-up calls, serving continental breakfast and giving out brown bag lunches.
- Clean-up Crew: 7:00 8:00 AM: clean the sleeping rooms including vacuuming and wiping down the sleep mats. Clean the dining area, kitchen and bathrooms.

Many members of the OLBS Good Samaritan Ministry donate to and volunteer at the Elk Grove PADS shelter, but more volunteers are needed. 


