### *The Journey of Teresa Joan "Tiny T"*

On June 24th our daughter Bridget and her husband Matt Wozniak were excited to go to the 20-week ultrasound appointment that would tell them the gender of their baby. Just months earlier, they lost a baby in the first trimester (Baby Asher), and they were anxious, but hopeful.

The news was devastating. Their daughter, whom they immediately named Teresa Joan, was diagnosed with severe fetal growth restriction and was in less than 1<sup>st</sup> percentile of growth, a condition described as "incompatible with life." Termination was one of the alternatives offered. Bridget and Matt made it clear that as Catholics termination was off the table. They committed to giving Teresa Joan, nicknamed Tiny T, a chance at life. Subsequent ultrasounds surfaced new problems, but sometimes issues were eliminated, such as a heart defect or limb deformity. They were encouraged to do more genetic tests and counseled on what would be required to care for a severely disabled child. These efforts did not discourage them from their commitment to Teresa Joan and their desire to honor her life. They surrendered to God's will and made a daily family rosary the heart of their prayer life.

Our immediate and extended family turned to prayer, asking our own parish family, our daughter's parish, the Carmelites in Des Plaines, relatives, friends, neighbors, and anyone they knew, to join us in prayer for Tiny T. We prayed for a miracle with mass intentions, daily rosaries, daily Divine Mercy chaplet, holy hours, prayers and novenas to Tiny T's patron saints: St Therese (The Little Flower), St Teresa of Avila, St Teresa of Calcutta, and St Joan of Arc. We prayed that Jesus would heal Teresa, that she would be born and live. As her parents said, *"We know God is with us every step of the way during this trial and we carry our cross alongside Christ's. Teresa is already a blessing, whether we have her for 1 second, 1 day, 1 year or a lifetime. But also, what a gift to steward her to Heaven if her time on earth is short."*

Their pastor told them that Teresa was given a mission. Teresa's dad describes it best: *"Teresa was sent to us to save us and bring us closer to Jesus, and to bring many others to God through prayer."* We have heard from many people that their prayers for Teresa Joan opened their hearts to God.

Tiny T lived far longer than the doctors expected. They don't know how or why she lived until September 7th when at 31 weeks and less than 2 lbs. she passed away in her mother's womb. We believe the miracle is that God kept her alive so her parents could tell the world, and medical staff who treated Bridget and Teresa, that Teresa Joan is a person, not a diagnosis, created in the image and likeness of God who deserved to be treated with dignity and loved unconditionally.

Tiny T was delivered peacefully on Sunday, September 8th, the Feast of the Nativity of the Blessed Mother, and spent the day held and loved by her parents, her 3 yr. old sister Arya, and her four grandparents. Before leaving the hospital, Bridget and Matt prayed a rosary in thanksgiving for Tiny T. Teresa Joan was laid to rest on September 28<sup>th</sup>, clothed in the tiny outfit lovingly made for her by *My Beautiful One* volunteers, her tiny hand holding the crucifix of her mother's rosary. Her beautiful funeral mass was attended by many, and her dad honored her with a deeply touching eulogy.

Tiny T was perfect. We know that she continues her mission in Heaven where she lives in the presence of God, and in the arms of Jesus, Mary and Joseph.

As her grandparents and witnesses to her journey, we believe that Tiny T is the face and voice of the unborn. The rate of abortion for babies with a severe diagnosis is very high. But that diagnosis should not negate their value or humanity. Teresa Joan inspires us to fight for the lives and dignity of the unborn children who are at risk every day. We hope you will too. Teresa Joan, pray for us!

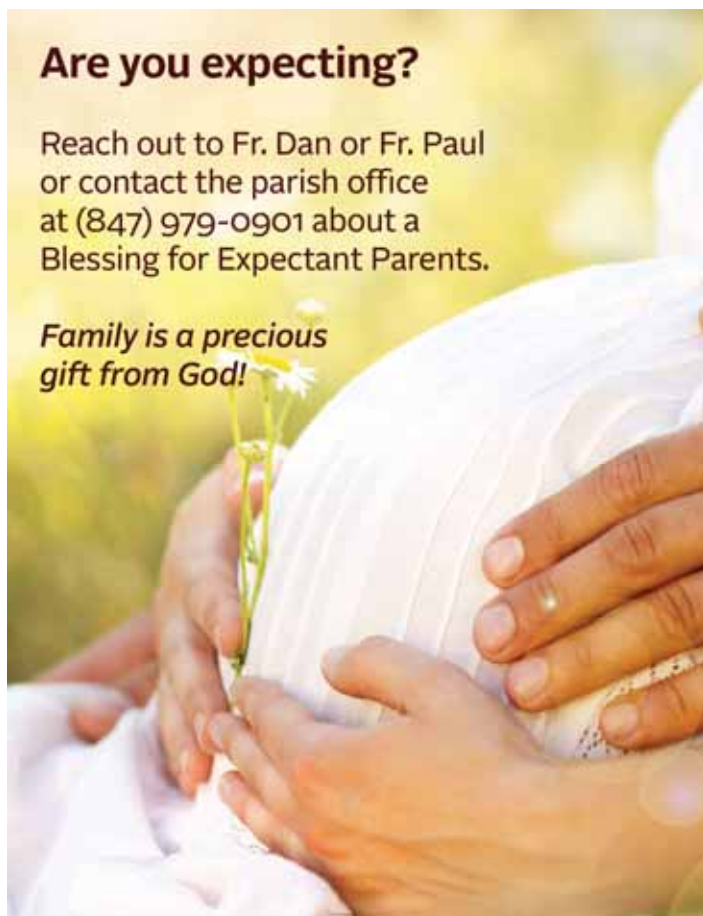

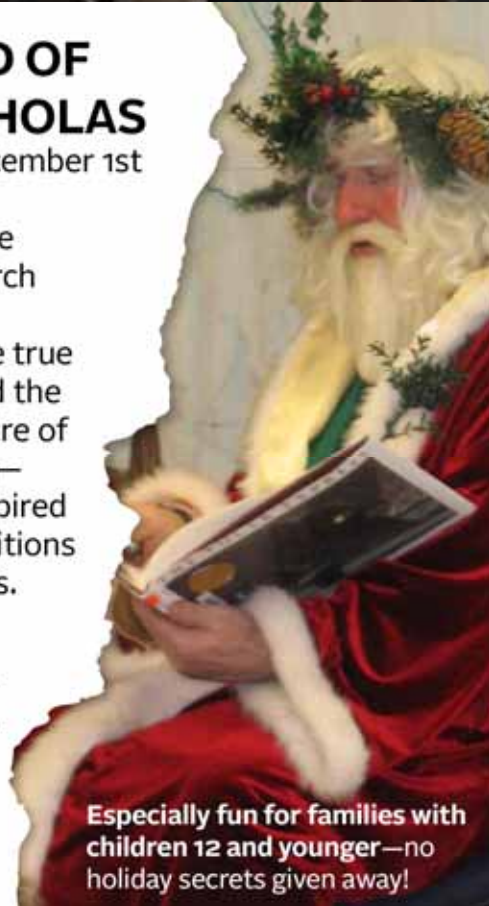
