

Just as John the Baptist calls us in this Sunday's Gospel to share what we have with others, choir members and other music ministers answer that call by lifting their voices in praise and enriching our worship. Whether it's a song or a second cloak, sharing what we've been blessed with is a powerful act of faith. Please enjoy this What's My Why from one of our Music Ministers.

Music is definitely a gift from God. I have been truly blessed throughout my entire life to be involved with music ministry. I feel singing has brought me closer to God. The lyrics of hymns are so prayerful, they make me want to "Shout for joy," (Zephaniah 3:14) as it says in our 1st reading, today. Being able to share my gift of music in the praise of God has given me such joy and happiness!

The musical opportunities here at Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Parish are open to all ages. I am honored to be a part of our newly formed group, "Cougar Cubs" open to children from birth to 4 years old. These youngest companions on our journey share fun and laughter through movement and singing as well as crafting with their guardians and friends. This brings children, parents, and guardians together in the Catholic setting of our Queen of the Rosary School once a month.

"Cry out with joy and gladness" (from our psalm this weekend) is a perfect description of a typical Wednesday afternoon with our own OLBS Kids Choir. Through singing and playing hand chimes, your children in 2nd through 8th grade, are learning the power of music in praising God. They are deepening their faith and increasing their understanding of the Mass. One parent told me that her child is much more attentive and interested during Mass since joining choir.

We begin each rehearsal with a prayer to St. Cecilia, the patron saint of musicians. We ask her to help us lift our voices in praise to God, for we know that singing is twice praying (St. Augustine). The choir members look forward to taking on the job of cantors. Your kids all enjoy singing, and are excited to get others singing for joy! Kids Choir rehearses on Wednesdays at 3:00pm in Queen of the Rosary Church (students may arrive as early as 2:40pm.) I also enjoy my role as cantor. During Mass, I look out at all of you and am overjoyed when I see—and hear you singing!

Because I love to sing, I am part of the Adult Choir. They are such a warm and welcoming group. The choir is open to all levels of singers. If you enjoy singing, you should join us! We rehearse at 7:00pm on Thursday evenings at St. Julian Eymard Church. If You want to come and sing some carols, we are singing this Sunday at 5:30pm in St. Julian Eymard—it's a beautiful service of Nine Lessons and Carols and the Kids' Choir will be joining the Adult Choir. The Adult Choir also leads a short program of carols beginning at 9:30pm on Christmas Eve, ahead of our 10:00pm Mass.

I am also honored to be able to participate with the Bell Choir. They are another caring group of musicians, and always open to new bell ringers. We practice at Queen of the Rosary Church on Wednesdays at 7:00pm. The sounds the bells create are heavenly!

Get in the Spirit of the Advent Season! Join us this Sunday, December 15th, for A Festival of Nine Lessons and Carols at 5:30pm at St. Julian Eymard Church. Enjoy an evening of scripture and song—the joy of Christmas awaits!




