

Under Mary's mantle, and with the guidance of the Holy Trinity, Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament seeks to share God's love by celebrating the sacraments, proclaiming the gospel, and serving the needs of all His children.

Dear Parish Family,

As you heard at Masses on Pentecost Sunday, we are entering into our Multi-Site Review process. As we continue to build Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Parish's new reality, this is an important time of reflection, evaluation and planning. We know this news may bring up questions, and we want to be as transparent and communicative as possible along the way. Below are some frequently asked questions to help explain where we are and what comes next:

Q: Where in the process are we?

We are at the very beginning! We are currently assembling the team that will lead this effort with input and guidance from the Archdiocese of Chicago.

Q: Is the Archdiocese forcing us to begin this review?

No. While a review of how we are using each worship site for Mass and Ministry was included in the Cardinal's 2020 decree, it wasn't feasible to begin at that time due to the global pandemic. The current review is a parish-initiated process.

Q: Is the timing of the review due to the change in pastorship?

No. Fr. Dan Folwaczny, in consultation with parish leadership, had already decided to begin this process before we learned that he would be reassigned and Fr. Arthur Bautista would be joining us on July 1, 2025.

Q: What is driving the timing of the review?

Like all parishes across the Archdiocese of Chicago, Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Parish is preparing to take part in the Generation to Generation: Answering the Call capital campaign. We will begin that process next year and parish leadership felt it was important to have a clear vision for our facilities before launching the campaign.

Q: Does the Archdiocese run this process?

No. Our parish Multi-Site Review Team will run the process, with support and best-practice guidance from the Archdiocese. The team, led by Julie Hirsch and Mark Sherman, will hold town halls and share periodcic updates through various parish communication channels.

Q: Has the Archdiocese already determined an outcome?

No. The Multi-Site Review Team will analyze many factors—such as facilities upkeep, usage and ministry needs—and will recommend a path forward to parish leadership. The final decision will be made by Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Parish.

Q: Does this mean one of our sites or buildings will be closing?

Not necessarily. That is just one of many possible outcomes. No decisions have been made, and nothing will be determined until the review process concludes.

Q: If we do decide to close one of our facilities, will that happen immediately?

No. If that outcome arises, the timeline would be set by parish leadership with careful consideration of the impact on worship, ministry and daily operations.

Q: Can anyone be on the Multi-Site Review Team?

The team leaders have already been selected. We met Julie Hirsch and Mark Sherman at Masses on Pentecost Sunday! They are now identifying additional members based on factors like experience of the parish and skillsets needed for the project. While not all volunteers may be selected, your willingness to serve is greatly appreciated.

Q: How long will the review take?

We expect to reach a decision on the continued use of the parish's facilities by the end of this calendar year.

We thank you in advance for your prayers, your trust and your active participation as we enter this season of discernment together. Stay tuned for more updates. Julie and Mark will be sharing more information soon!

What is an area of your life where you feel "hungry"?



entire family—this one's going to be special.










