

# Pentecost Sunday | June 8, 2025

Under Mary's mantle, and with the guidance of the Holy Trinity, Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament seeks to share God's love by celebrating the sacraments, proclaiming the gospel, and serving the needs of all His children.

#### **INSPIRED BY PENTECOST**

On this Pentecost Sunday, we hear the powerful words of Jesus in the Gospel of John: "The Advocate, the Holy Spirit whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you." (John 14:26). What a moment! The disciples, once afraid and uncertain, receive the Holy Spirit and with it, the boldness and clarity to proclaim Christ to the world. This isn't just a story of long ago. It's the story of the Church today. It's our story. It's our mission.

In the months ahead, we'll be hearing a lot more about **evangelization** here at Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Parish. This isn't a new program or an isolated ministry. Evangelization is a culture. Or as Pope Francis once said, "the oxygen that invigorates and purifies Christian life." And it's the culture we've been building together over the last five years. It's at the heart of what it means to be Church: to encounter Christ, to be transformed by His love and to share that love with others.

If we look back at our recent pastoral themes, we see the movement of the Holy Spirit:

Healing, Hope and Hospitality (Luke 19:1-10)

**Be Transformed: Discerning the Will of God** (Romans 12:2)

**Be Transformed: Discovering Our Charisms** (Romans 12:6)

Each year has been a building block, inviting us deeper into relationship with God and one another, capturing the essence of evangelization: sharing the Gospel not from a place of obligation, but from a place of authenticity, love and joy while being a source of love and inspiration for one another.

In his very first papal address, Pope Leo XIV shared, "We have to look together how to be a missionary Church, building bridges, dialogue, always open to receiving with open arms for everyone..."

This mission of Evangelization belongs to **all of us.** Evangelization isn't just a team, a ministry or a committee. There will be opportunities for everyone to get involved, and we are so excited to be on this journey with you. Stay tuned. Be open. Be prayerful. And above all, be ready—because the Spirit is moving.


