## A MESSAGE FROM FR. ARTHUR BAUTISTA

Dear Parishioners of Our Lady  
of the Blessed Sacrament,

My name is Fr. Arthur Bautista, and I am honored  
and excited to begin this new journey with all  
of you.

I was born and raised in the Philippines, where  
I first felt the call to the priesthood during my  
high school years. At the age of 16, I entered the  
college seminary in the Philippines. A few years  
into my formation, my family made the significant  
decision to move to the United States. At the time,  
I thought this was a sign from God that perhaps the  
priesthood was not my path.

Shortly after arriving in the U.S., I worked as a  
dietary aide for a year, then as a nursing assistant,  
and at the same time in a group home serving  
adults with developmental challenges. While these  
experiences were valuable and humbling, I felt a  
deep sense of unfulfillment that I couldn't ignore.  
That restlessness led me back to the seminary—  
this time in Epworth, Iowa, with the Divine  
Word Missionaries.

After completing my college seminary studies, I  
discerned a call to diocesan priesthood and joined  
the Archdiocese of Chicago. In 2016, I began my  
formation at Mundelein Seminary, and in 2020, at  
the height of the global pandemic, I was ordained  
to the priesthood.

My first assignment was at St. Margaret Mary  
Parish, which later became part of the newly  
formed Holy Child Jesus Parish. I spent five  
formative years there, and during that time, I was  
also asked to serve as one of the Vocation Directors  
for the Archdiocese.

Now, I find myself here—grateful, hopeful, and  
ready to serve.

Many people have told me that I have “big shoes  
to fill” following Fr. Dan's wonderful leadership.  
But I don't believe I'm here to fill anyone's shoes.

Fr. Dan and I may be different, and that's okay.  
I don't intend to be another Fr. Dan—I will be  
Fr. Art. And I promise to give my whole self to  
this community.

I do ask one thing of you: please teach me how  
to minister to you. I may be your new pastor, but  
I don't know everything. Help me grow into the  
shepherd you need—one after the heart of Jesus,  
the Good Shepherd.

May God, who has begun a good work here, bring it  
to fulfillment.
