### Now Enrolling: Education for Grades K–8!

Our Religious Education program is back in full swing, and we're excited to welcome students in Grades K through 8 for another year of faith, friendship and formation! If you're looking for a program that helps your child grow in their relationship with Jesus while learning the richness of our Catholic faith in a supportive, joy-filled environment, you've found it!

**Registration is open now through September 14th.** Don't delay!

Classes are held in our Queen of the Rosary School (690 Elk Grove Blvd, Elk Grove Village, behind Queen of the Rosary Church). This year, we will follow the same great format:

- **Grades 5–8 meet on Tuesday evenings from 7:00–8:15 PM**, beginning **September 23**
- **Grades K–4 meet on Saturday mornings from 9:15–10:30 AM**, beginning **September 28**

Each year builds upon the last, helping our students encounter Christ in meaningful, age-appropriate ways. Our **Second Grade program** focuses on preparing for **First Eucharist**, helping students understand and appreciate the incredible gift of receiving Jesus in the Eucharist—not just once, but at every Mass throughout their lives! And our **Eighth Grade program** centers on preparation for **Confirmation**, guiding young people as they prepare to become fully-initiated members of the Catholic Church, strengthened by the gifts of the Holy Spirit.

We're also excited to share that this year brings new leadership! **Mrs. Nagle**, a beloved former teacher in our Queen of the Rosary School, has stepped into the role of **Lifelong Faith Formation Coordinator**. She brings with her years of experience in both early childhood and middle school education, a deep love of Christ and a passionate commitment to walking with families as they raise children in the faith. Mrs. Nagle is especially looking forward to helping students take their faith beyond the classroom—participating in liturgies, volunteering in the parish and exploring ways to serve our wider community.

Under her leadership, you'll notice a strengthened connection between parish and school in **Sacramental Preparation**—especially for **First Eucharist and Confirmation**. From **Baptism to Funerals**, our families will feel supported by a cohesive, prayerful approach to lifelong formation.

Mrs. Nagle also leads our **Altar Server Ministry**, training and scheduling students in **grades 4 and up** to serve at **Sunday Masses, Holy Days, Weddings and Funerals**. Serving at the altar is a beautiful way for our young people to serve the Church and grow in confidence and faith while gaining a deeper understanding of the Mass.

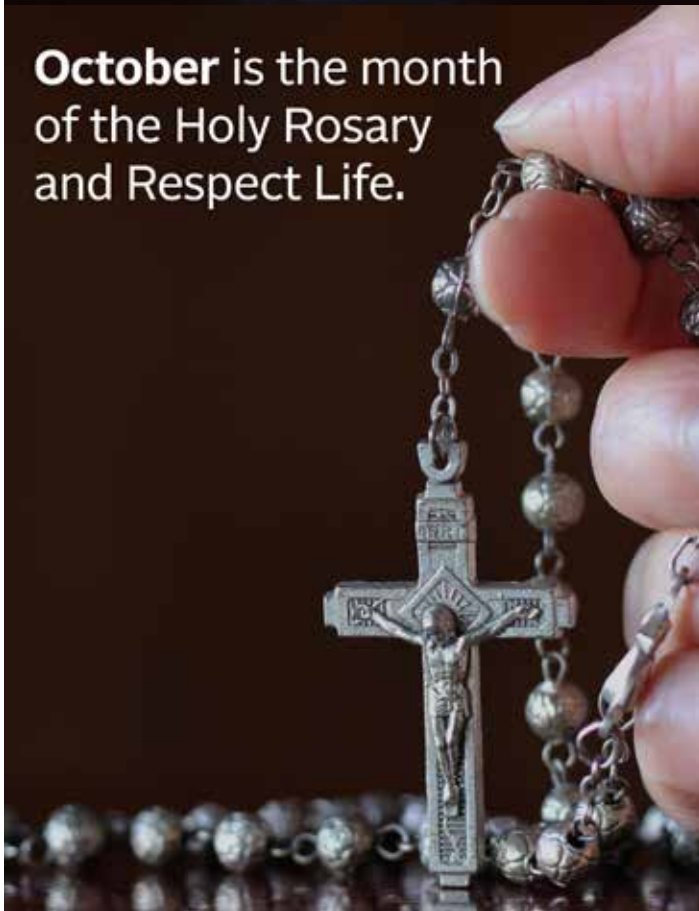




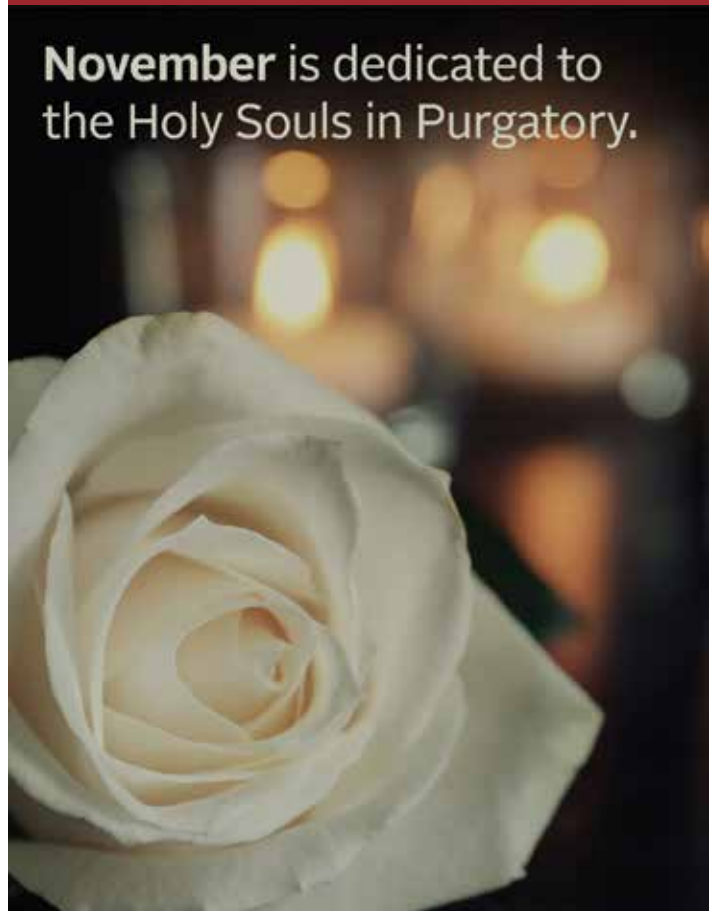
