

#### **Evangelization Update**

Our Evangelization efforts are off to a wonderful start this fall! Our **Alpha Pilot** is in full swing, and our leadership team reports excellent participation. My heartfelt thanks to the team helping launch Alpha, to all those participating in the pilot, and to everyone praying for, donating to, and otherwise supporting this exciting initiative.

Our **Religious Education** program is likewise in full swing, and I'm very grateful for the leadership of **Mrs. Christine Nagle**, our new **Lifelong Faith Formation Coordinator**. Our **Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA)** program kicked off with a dozen participants—ranging in age from **8 to 77**! We've doubled the number of candidates from last year and even needed to recruit an additional instructor to assist Fr. Paul. My thanks to last year's Elect who came back to share their personal experiences with this year's group. Stay tuned for more about how we as a parish can walk with and welcome our candidates as they prepare to complete their Sacraments at the Easter vigil.

Don't miss our other great opportunities to **grow in faith and community**! There's a Bible Study for nearly every schedule: Tuesday Morning Six Weeks with the Bible, Wednesday Morning Bible Study, and Bible Timeline on Wednesday evenings. And finally, **Respect Life Month** and **Month of the Holy Rosary** continue with a full calendar of prayer and service. Please keep an eye on our bulletin and eNewsletter for all upcoming events. Thank you for all you do to make our parish a place where **faith is lived, shared, and celebrated**.




