

# Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time | October 26, 2025

Under Mary's mantle, and with the guidance of the Holy Trinity, Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament seeks to share God's love by celebrating the sacraments, proclaiming the gospel, and serving the needs of all His children.

### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

What a truly grace-filled October we have shared as a parish family! As we celebrated both Respect Life Month and the Month of the Holy Rosary, our community came together in prayer, reflection, and fellowship to honor the sacredness of life from conception to natural death. I continue to be moved by the spirit of faith and unity that fills Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Pparish, and I am especially grateful to our Respect Life and Rosary Ministry coordinators and volunteers who poured so much heart into creating meaningful opportunities for prayer and connection throughout the month.

We began October with a special screening of The Sound of Hope: The Story of Possum Trot, a powerful film that set the tone for our monthlong reflection on the gift of life and the beauty of family. From there, parishioners gathered each Wednesday to pray the Rosary for Life, lifting up intentions that touched every stage and circumstance of the human journey—from miscarriage and loss of a child, to adoption and abortion, to the challenges of aging, euthanasia, and mental health. These evenings of prayer were moments of compassion and solidarity, reminding us of the hope and mercy that flow from Christ through His Mother's intercession.

In addition, we recognized the National Day of Awareness for Mental Health—an important reminder that mental health is an essential part of human dignity and well-being. This **Sunday**, **October 26 at 6pm**, we will host our first parish Grace Night of Prayer for Mental Health at St. Julian Eymard Church. This special evening of prayer and reflection invites us to bring our struggles, hopes, and loved ones before the Lord, trusting in His healing and peace. You may have already noticed the **Mental Health Prayer Intention Boxes** in the vestibules at each church; I encourage you to continue sharing the names of those for whom you are praying as they journey toward greater mental and emotional wholeness.

Our Respect Life Ministry also represented our parish at the **Northwest Families for Life March for Life** last weekend, joining Catholics from across the area to witness publicly to the dignity of every human person. Midway through the month, we were blessed to welcome the **Pilgrim Statue of Our Lady of Fatima**. Parishioners gathered nightly to pray the

Fatima Rosary, and those evenings were filled with grace—a true outpouring of love and trust in Mary's maternal care.

October was a month overflowing with faith! As we turn the calendar to November, our focus shifts to remembrance and gratitude. We begin with the Solemnity of All Saints on Saturday, November 1. Because the feast falls on a Saturday this year, it is not a Holy Day of Obligation, and we will celebrate it at our 8:15am morning Mass at Queen of the Rosary Church.

On Sunday, November 2, we commemorate **All Souls Day**. All weekend Masses, including the 5pm Vigil at St. Julian Eymard, will honor the faithful departed. Our 10:30am Mass at Queen of the Rosary Church will be a special **Mass of Remembrance** for those from our parish family who have been called to eternal rest during the past year. Later in the month, we will mark the **Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe**, followed by the national **Thanksgiving holiday**. On **Thanksgiving Day** (Thursday, November 27), we will celebrate daily Mass at Queen of the Rosary Church at a special time of 9am, giving thanks to God for His blessings.

November concludes with the **First Sunday of Advent**—the beginning not only of a new liturgical season but a new liturgical year. In Cycle A, we will hear primarily from the Gospel of Matthew.

Stay tuned to our parish communications for details about our upcoming Advent and Christmas celebrations. May we continue to walk together in faith, hope, and love as Companions on the Journey, giving thanks for all that God is doing in our midst.




