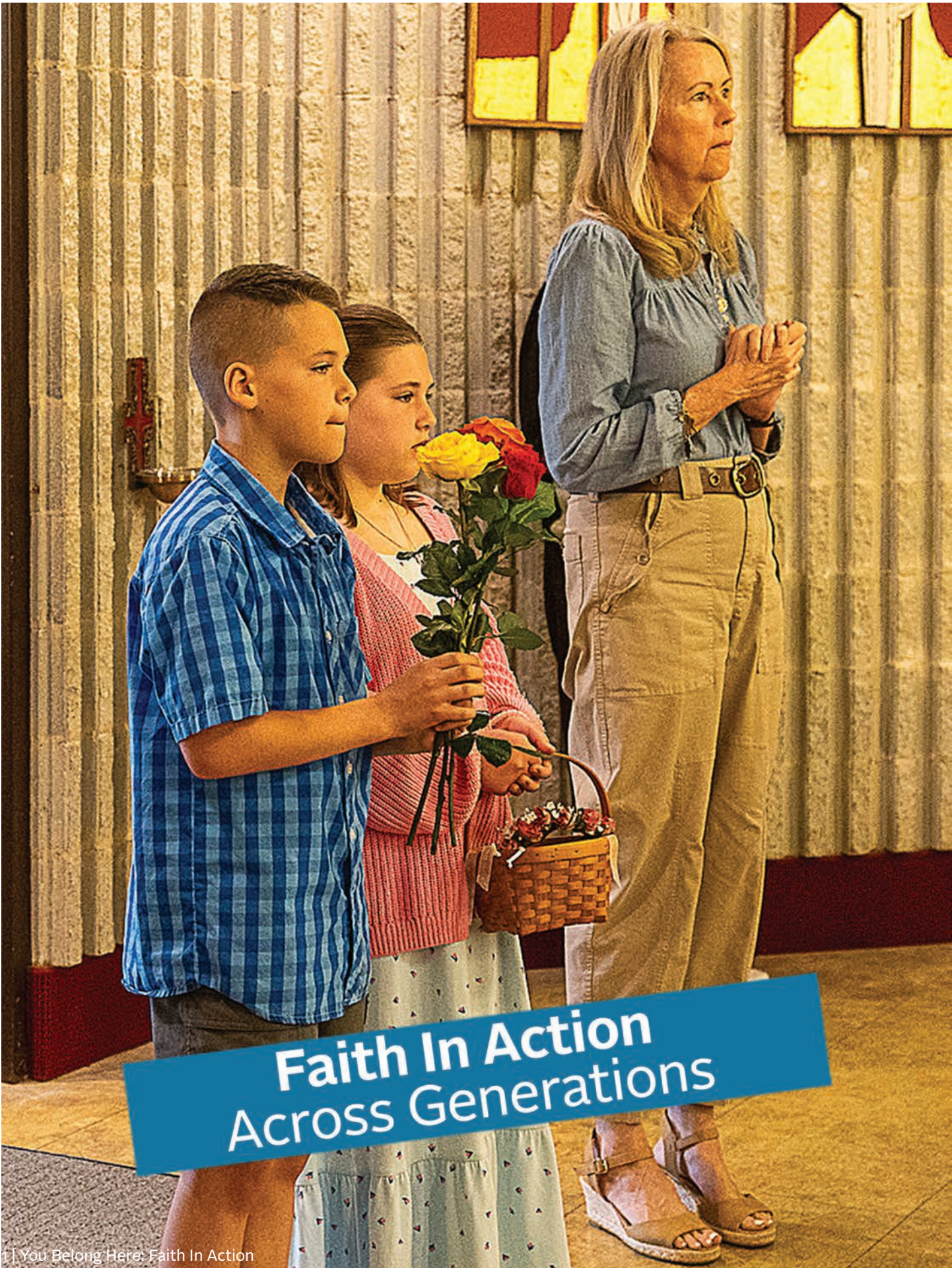

No matter where you are on your faith journey, there is a place for you here at Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Parish.

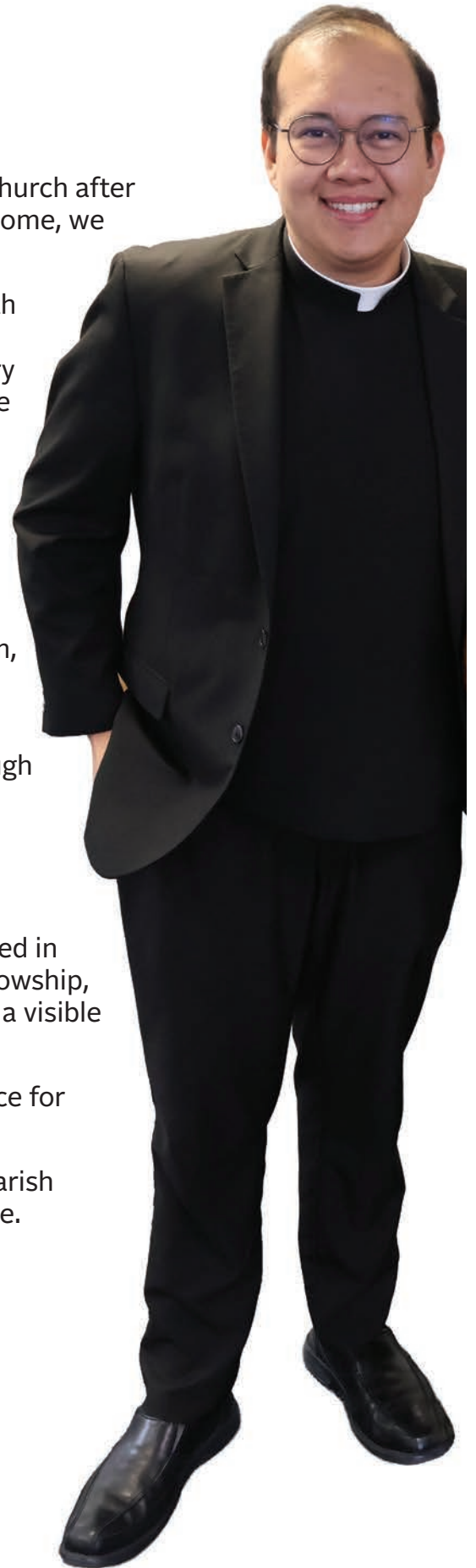
We invite you to join us for Mass, introduce yourself to our parish family, and explore the many ways to grow in faith and service.

Restrooms are available off of the narthex in both Queen of the Rosary Church and St. Julian Eymard Church. Our restrooms are handicapped accessible and provide changing tables.

We encourage first-time visitors to arrive 10–15 minutes early to get settled, pick up a bulletin, and introduce yourself to one of our Greeters or Ushers. They'll be happy to help you find your way and answer any questions.

Bible Study – deeper faith and understanding through prayer, Scripture, and shared reflection.

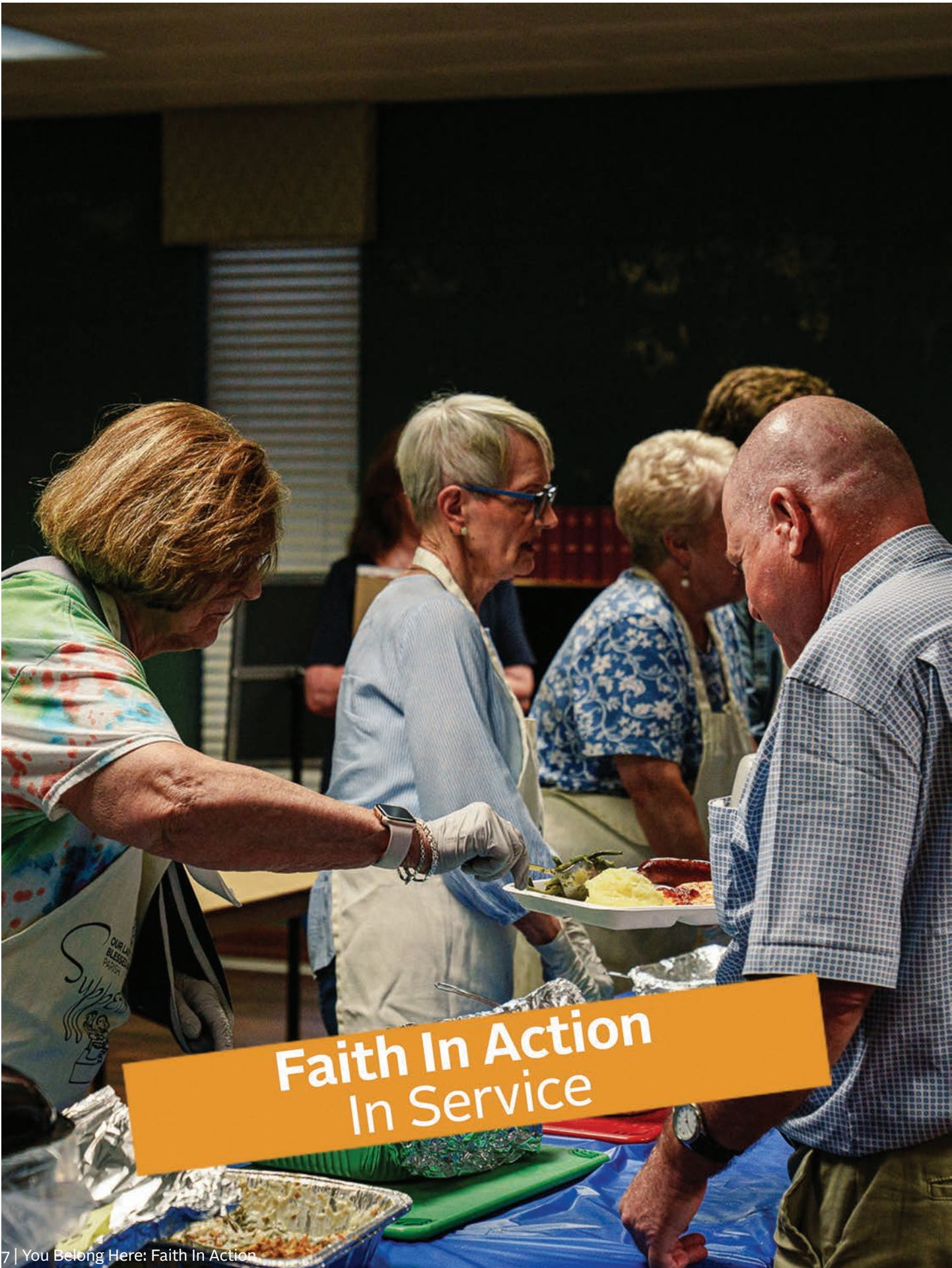
Men's/Women's Groups – building fellowship, encouragement, and faith-centered friendships

Queen of the Rosary School

For more than 65 years, Queen of the Rosary School has partnered with parents, the primary educators of their children, to provide a faith-based education rooted in Catholic values, academic excellence, and whole-child formation.

Serving students from PreKindergarten through 8th Grade, our school community is committed to nurturing each child spiritually, academically, socially, emotionally, and physically through age-appropriate curriculum designed to support, challenge, and inspire learners at every stage of development.

Recognized nationally as a 2011 Blue Ribbon Award Winner, Queen of the Rosary School combines strong academics with a caring, family-centered environment where students are known, encouraged, and empowered to grow in faith and confidence.

Our Early Childhood program includes a sensory classroom designed to support hands-on learning, exploration, and developmental growth for our youngest learners.

Beyond the classroom, students are encouraged to discover their gifts and build community through athletics, leadership, service, and extracurricular opportunities. Beginning in 4th Grade, students may participate in Volleyball, Basketball, Soccer, and Softball, while programs like Robotics foster creativity, teamwork, and problem-solving skills.

Our engaged parent community helps enrich student life through special opportunities and traditions including Art Appreciation, Movie Days, school celebrations, service projects, and family events that strengthen the partnership between school, parish, and home.

At Queen of the Rosary School, students are formed not only for academic success, but for lives of faith, service, leadership, and purpose.

Religious Education

Our Religious Education program partners with families to help children and teens grow in their relationship with Jesus Christ and deepen their understanding of the Catholic faith in a welcoming, engaging, and age-appropriate environment.

Serving students from Kindergarten through high school sacramental preparation years, our program combines faith formation, Scripture, prayer, Catholic traditions, service opportunities, and community-building experiences designed to help young people live their faith both inside and outside the classroom.

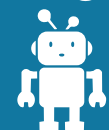
