## A MESSAGE FROM FR. ARTHUR

Dear Parishioners,

After much prayer and discernment, I have asked Cardinal Blase Cupich for a leave of absence from active ministry in the Archdiocese of Chicago. This leave will take effect on October 1, 2026. Cardinal Cupich has also given me permission to continue my priestly ministry for a time in my home diocese in the Philippines.

This has been one of the most difficult decisions I have ever made. I love being a priest, and I deeply cherish the vocation God has entrusted to me. It is precisely because I love the priesthood that I believe I need this time away—to pray, to reflect, and to listen more attentively to the voice of God. My hope is to discern more clearly wherever God may be calling me to serve His people.

Although I have spent only one year with you as your priest and pastor, I have grown and learned so much from my experience here at Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament. The people I have met, the experiences we have shared, and the challenges we have faced together have enriched me both personally and as a priest. I will carry these lessons and memories with me and draw from them in my priestly ministry in the years to come. For this, I am deeply grateful for the opportunity to have served you as your pastor.

I would also like to inform you that Reverend Michael Owen has been appointed as the new administrator of Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Parish, effective October 1, 2026. I have had the opportunity to speak with Fr. Michael about this transition, and I am grateful that he will be entrusted with the care of this parish community. I ask you to welcome him warmly and to offer him the same generosity, faith, and support that you have so graciously shown me. I am confident that God will continue to bless Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Parish and guide it into the future.

Although my ministry at Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Parish is coming to an end, you will always remain in my prayers and hold a special place in my heart. The relationships we have formed and the memories we have shared will always be a cherished part of my priestly journey.

As I begin this time of prayer and discernment, I humbly ask you to keep me in your prayers. Please pray that I may have the wisdom to hear God's voice, the courage to follow His will, and the peace that comes from trusting in Him. Be assured of my prayers for each of you and for our parish family.

Thank you for allowing me the privilege of serving as your pastor. It has been an honor and a blessing that I will carry with me wherever the Lord leads me next.

May God bless you abundantly, and may Our Lady continue to watch over you and our parish always.

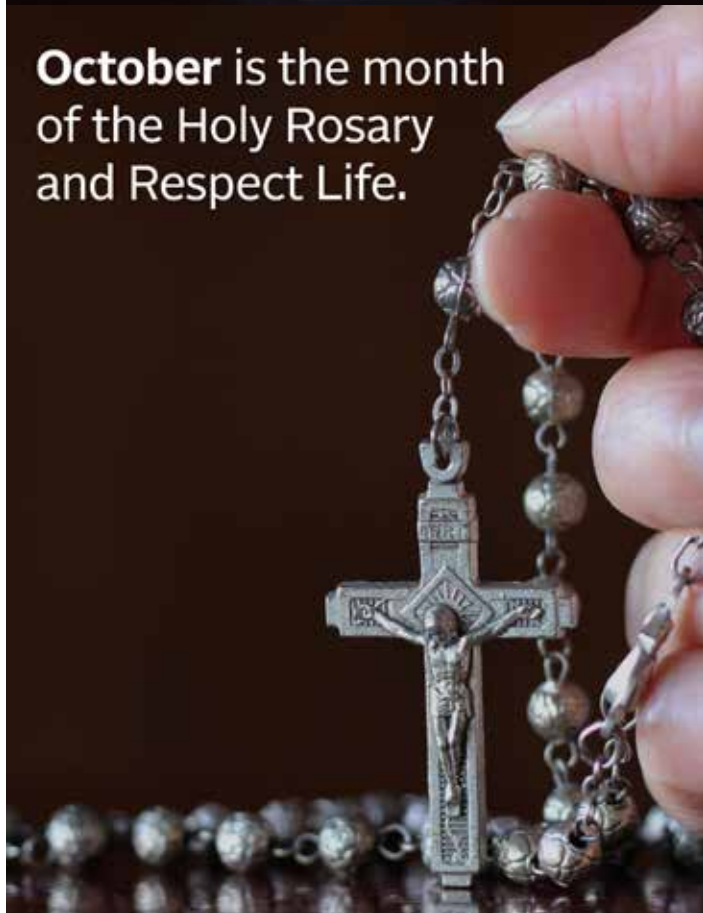

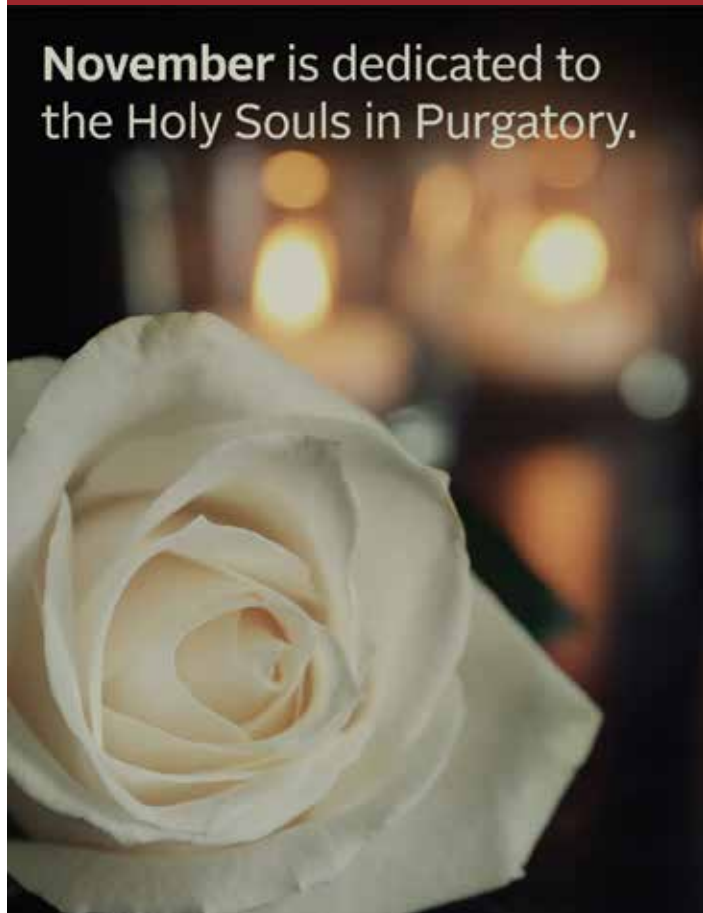

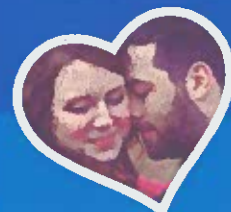
